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PREFACE

As I mentioned in my dedication, I was raised by two people that held morals and values to a high degree. My mother always encouraged me to be my own person, someone that should not run to and fro and cling to every new fad that comes along, but to remain on a solid rock foundation. Mom always dragged me to church on Sunday and although it was an Episcopal church with all of its tradition and it being boring as hell, did give me a rudimentary form of faith that would always cling with me to the day that I became Born Again when the fruits of YHVH's labors in my life blossomed like a new leaf. It was not long after my conversion that she too came to a born-again faith in YHVH through Yeshua.

My dad was a good father. He had to daily overcome the PTSD that he suffered from fighting in the Korean War and although life was hard for him, he persevered. Dad didn't care much for church. He had both seen and been a victim of the arrogance that Christians can show and being a man that loathed infidelity he chose not to be part of religious tradition. Like my mother, my dad came to faith in YHVH through Yeshua not long after I did. His reason for choosing faith in Yeshua was that he saw the change that YHVH had done to me and he wanted the same.

My dad was not a big man when it came to stature, but he was a giant when it came to faith. I consider myself a researcher, but where research is concerned my dad was incredible. He researched the Masonic Order and wrote a fantastic paper that is published on my website. He

would befriend people that belonged to cults so that he could minister to them and he planted many seeds for YHVH's Kingdom in people of many faiths and belief systems.

From an early age both of my parents instilled in both me and my sister a sense of right and wrong, based mostly on the Ten Commandments. Although dad didn't attend church he held to the tenants of the Judeo/Christian ethic. My family was always seen as being sort of odd by our neighbors. As far as I know, we were the only people of Italian extract that were not Roman Catholic. My paternal grandfather converted to Protestantism when he was a young man, his reason being, "I got tired of seeing people act pious in church and then get into fist-fights outside the church doors." In addition, that same grandfather was a very honest man and he hated lies and criminal activity. Coming from a town in New Jersey where many of the people were Italian it was not uncommon to see people finding loopholes in the system of law to gain and profit. My grandfather would have none of it. He even resigned from being the town's health inspector because people wanted to pay him off for favors and he would not do it. Frankly, I think that he was forced out because of his honesty.

I could share a thousand stories about how unique our family was but it would take too much time and I don't want to give glory to my family, but to YHVH who is the one that authored any good that our family did or does.

Later in life I was shown from family members and later through DNA tests that we were of Jewish extract. Back in that day being Jewish was not a good thing in the eyes of the Gentiles who denied opportunities to Jews and persecuted Jews, so keeping quiet was the best thing to do.

They kept so quiet that I didn't find out about my heritage until I was in my thirties. All of my life until that revelation I had exhibited Jewish mannerisms and never knew why. I also found it easy to form friendships with Jewish kids and once in my adolescent years I expressed to a wrong relative that I wanted to convert to Judaism. When I finally found out about my heritage it made sense to me why I had and still have such a love for jurisprudence and why I see things so black and white, which I still see as good qualities.

Back in my early Christian days I attended a church where everyone was giving great accolades to the pastor. He was almost treated like a messianic figure. I have to admit that he did have a charismatic air about him, but I later found out that his perceived greatness was just fancy gift wrapping but inside the man was a wolf in sheep's clothing. During this time YHVH was revealing things to me about this pastor, through divine revelation but also by the testimony of others who like me could hear him say things that very few heard him say during sermons. I later learned that this was called discernment, and boy did YHVH give me a good dose of it.

During and after my time in that church something happened to me. I began to see that there was what appeared to be a contagious cancer that was infecting a great many churches and that the contagion was spreading like wildfire. I had spent my early Christian days in the Assemblies of God church, a church that is Pentecostal in belief. While I didn't agree with all of the tenants of Pentecostalism I liked the worship and the messages were lively. However, there was a new movement that was birthed a few years earlier that they called Charismatic Faith. It seemed to be more in tune with the Ruach Ha Kodesh and at the time the Gifts of The Ruach were moving in a biblical manner within the movement.

So, I started to attend a church called The Vineyard. Not too long afterward there was a split in the Vineyard movement. It seemed that the original movement became stagnant while those that split from the original Vineyard were getting into some pretty strange stuff. I left the Vineyard and attended a Foursquare church because it seemed to be built upon a firmer foundation. Things went well at the Foursquare church until it started to get into the doctrine of Tithing. I was becoming confused because this church that was telling me that the Torah died on the cross with Yeshua was demanding that I follow a tenant of the Torah, that being tithing. Was the law abolished or not, you cannot have it both ways.

I sought out YHVH on the matter and He led me through a Bible Study and also to a teaching on Tithing by Dr. Roy Blizzard. I was convinced (and still am) that the doctrine of Tithing is not a doctrine supported by the Brit Hadasha. So, I made the mistake of sharing my study with a brother in the church on the grounds that he not share it with anyone else. That was a big mistake. His brother in-law was an elder in the church and my friend felt compelled to share it with him. The final result was that I got a visit from his brother in-law telling me that either I change my mind, or I leave the church. A few weeks later I chose the latter.

Since that time, I have visited many churches in search for a place to call home. Once, I noticed that a church I was attending was disenfranchising the older members in an attempt to bring new blood into the church. I wanted to bolt from that place, but YHVH had different plans. I had to stay until I was given the all-clear from the Ruach Ha Kodesh. I stayed there almost a year, going to church to pray for the service and the church in general. After a year the church

did change for the better but was still a mess. I had a talk with the pastor which resulted in me being told to leave. He saw me as a threat I guess.

I have been a believer in YHVH Yeshua for thirty-nine years and during that time I have seen the New Age creep into the church along with political correctness. When I've tried to broach the subject, I would be dismissed as being judgmental and/or pharisaical. In 1999 I started a web presence to address what I was seeing in the Church at Large. To my surprise and with heavy sadness I started to receive letters from people that saw the same things that I saw and who like me stopped attending church on a regular basis.

I know that people like to condemn people who do not attend church. They base their belief on a scripture that tells believers not to forsake the gathering of the saints. What they fail to realize is that when two or more gather in Yeshua's name here is there and so is church. I do attend church from time to time along with my wife, but we both become disappointed after a few weeks because the church is either New Age in nature or they hold to doctrines that we do not see as being biblical. It is church that has changed, not us.

The focus of this book is to look at the surreal belief system of something called The New Apostolic Reformation. I am afraid that some of you might think that we are making some of the NAR's strange beliefs up or that I'm fabricating a lie to bring down a church. In reality, the NAR, and its churches are into some very bizarre doctrines. The sad thing is that churches, like Bethel Redding are so influential to so many Charismatic believers that the abominable doctrines are being accepted by Christians who think that if a church is right on some things it

has to be right about all things. Lest I remind you that rat poison is made up of 99 percent good food and 1 percent poison, yet it is deadly.

So, with these things in mind let me present to you the bizarre doctrines of the Charismaniac movement, or what it has evolved into, so that you know what is real and what you should avoid. I present good and solid knowledge. Please don't perish because of lack of knowledge. Please read this book to the end because it might save you from getting involved in something that you will find hard to extract yourself from in the future.

CHAPTER ONE

THE NEW APOSTOLIC REFORMATION

DOMINIONISM, REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY AND EZEKIEL 22

If you've read my blog you know things about me. I'm of Jewish extract, with some gentile thrown in. I'm a Born-Again believer in Yeshua Ha Mashiach. I was saved at the tail end of what is known as the "Jesus Movement," back in the 1970's. I consider myself to be a Baptist-Costal, meaning that I like the strength that can be found in Christian Fundamentalism and the freedom that can be found in the Ruach Ha Kodesh, which is found in Pentecostalism. I believe in living in and practicing the gifts of the Ruach Ha Kodesh but keeping that in check by examining everything and everyone through the lens of the Tanakh and the Brit Hadasha (Old and New Testaments). I know that freedom is good, but people can get carried away when they don't check freedom with reality and common sense, and again, the lens of Biblical Scripture. I believe, "YHVH said it, I believe it, that settles it." I believe that everything better mesh with scripture (in its entirety) and that if it doesn't then it is to be cast off to the burn pile.

Also, many of you know that for a long time, (and still to some extent) I was involved in the Christian UFO Research Community, and much of the research that branches off from that. One of the major things that caused me to separate myself from that "community," was that people weren't willing to work together and, people weren't willing to look deeply into the new

research that others found that could shed light into revelations of the demonic phenomenon that is UFO, aliens and abduction.

There was a hierarchy established in the CUFORC (Christian UFO Research Community) where those who were educated and those who had financial resources took the reins, and the people that they endorsed, and who would kowtow to their rules for doing things were promoted, and those who wanted to be led by the YHVH and His Ruach Ha Kodesh were cast off and humiliated either by direct means or by silence. I saw copyrighted work used without permission by some of these elite entities and many times they would present those things as their own revelations. I've seen these people twist scripture and contort YHVH's context in scripture to the ultimate degree and I've seen them explain it away as revelation. When proven wrong, I've seen these same people either start smear campaigns against those who have proven them wrong, and/or they go through some elaborate measures to sweep their heresy under the rug.

Unfortunately, I've seen the same actions in churches that I've attended. When I was young I excused these things away as ignorance on the offender's part, but I've learned that the big difference between ignorant, and willingly ignorant is the first will repent, and the second will not. If a person is genuinely led by the Ruach Ha Kodesh, there is always a sense of humility and contriteness and when they're approached about their error, they will usually agree because the Ruach has been telling them the same thing all along. It may not happen that very same day, but it will happen in a relatively short period of time. To me there is nothing worse than having the Ruach Ha Kodesh tugging at my conscience when I have been wrong about something. There always seems to be an urgency about getting the problem fixed so that peace of spirit can be

restored. Also, there is no better feeling than when conflicts are resolved, and peace brings one's ruach back into line with YHVH's Ruach.

One way to tell if someone is a genuine believer is to see how they respond to conflict between themselves and others. If they feel bad and want to resolve the problem quickly then they are led by YHVH. If they deny that they are at fault (when they actually are) and/or they try to trivialize the seriousness of the infraction, or if they try to cast blame on others, or if they try to ruin the reputation of the other by telling lies or casting condemnation at the other, they are probably not led by YHVH's Ruach.

Many of you reading this book are true believers in Yeshua. Therefore, you are adopted as sons and daughters by Aveinu (our Father) and having that relationship should cause us to hate everything that Abba hates. We should hate sin. Sin should nauseate us, and it should want to make us recoil from it. We should hate pride and haughtiness, hate lust, hate the love of Mammon and all of the things that Abba hates:

These six things doth the Lord hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren. Proverbs 6:16-19

One thing that pisses me off more than anything else is when people take YHVH's Word and they pervert its meaning. This is usually done for the purposes of misleading people and leading them down the path of destruction. Twisting and contorting the meaning that YHVH has for His Word embodies all of the things that YHVH hates. When a person distorts scripture, they

are usually doing it for personal gain, or fulfill some sort of lust or deception that they have in their own heart. This is the pride that the proverb talks about.

Twisted scripture is always preached by a lying tongue. Taking scripture out of context almost always ultimately leads to the shedding of blood. Want an example, look at Jonestown back in the 1970's; look at all of those people who saw all of the Jewish people as Christ Killers when the Bible says that it was the Jewish leadership and the Romans that did it.....shall I continue, because it could turn into a very long paragraph if I do. In order to purpose to twist scripture a person has to, in addition to being prideful, have wicked thoughts and imaginations because the twisting of scripture is just a manifestation of fulfilling the wicked imaginations.

Did you ever notice that when a person has evil intent, they usually don't stew on it? No, they are quick to run with it and they want to get it broadcast as soon as they possibly can. As we have witnessed, the internet is an excellent way to do this. Yes, this is technically not using the physical foot, that is true. Back in biblical times they obviously didn't have computers. To get a message out quickly they had runners who would run from one city to another, or one house to another. It was the ancient equivalent to the internet or television or radio. Therefore, in modern application, we can substitute and/or include the word feet with device or medium. The internet, television and radio are mediums (channels) to get information out. So, using the Hebrew definitions for the words in the scripture, it can be rendered in modern fashion as:

A person using an electronic medium to quickly bring evil

Of course, when YHVH's Word is contorted for personal gain or evil intent it is always used in a lying fashion. For instance, Yeshua taught about sin and hell more than he talked about

anything else during his ministry on earth. We also know that when he taught not to “judge,” he meant that we’re not to condemn, or proclaim a sentence against someone. He did tell us to inspect the fruit that people produce, and that is how you would know them. Both words mean to judge. However, when a people like Joel Olsteen won’t preach about sin and hell because he doesn’t want to judge them, there can be no doubt that this man is using an electronic medium to quickly bring evil to people.

This brings us to the next part of the proverb, a false witness that speaks lies. When anyone pervert’s scripture and they teach others, they are false witnesses because they are giving different meaning to what YHVH meant when He dictated the scripture to the author. Okay, now we come to the final part of the proverb, “he that soweth discord among brethren.” There are many examples of this today. The following is an example, and a true story. There is a man that was leading people down the wrong path. I approached him about his practices and he denied that he was wrong, and even tried to back up his actions using scripture. Anyone with an eye to see and an ear to hear could see that he was teaching heresy. I knew that several others had approached him in similar fashion.

The next process was to bring it to the church. Since we lived far apart this was not possible. So, I wrote an editorial about his actions, directed to the Church in general. It showed his beliefs in his own words, his contortion of scripture, in his own words and showed where he was in error. As a result of this, he came after me and tried to ruin the ministry that YHVH gave to me. His wife took several of the things that I have posted on the internet and tried to cast me as a person who was listening to and telling the lies of demons. Of course, this man had (still has) disciples who took up his cause, not seeing the whole story.

Of course, there were some who came to my defense. What came about was a he said / he said dispute that was definitely discord between brethren. What could have been resolved in a godly way was made into a public spectacle because his wife decided to get into the mix and accuse me of preaching doctrines of demons and listening to familiar spirits. Had this man just dwelt on what I tried to tell him, or even if he heeded the correction in the editorial it could have been resolved. I sort of knew that this was not going to happen given this man's personality type and his walk or not walking with YHVH. However, his wife accelerated things by getting into the mix, make false accusations and it led to a lot of discord.

Yes, there are a lot of people who this world would see as much higher in caliber that fall into the classification of doing the things that YHVH hates. A good example of what the "Church" has become can be seen in Ezekiel 22. It addresses four groups of people; the princes, the people, the priests and the prophets. One might ask why I chose this scripture to use as an example. Well, I felt led to it by YHVH. You see, the people who are involved in all of the camps listed in the title: the Dominionists; those in Replacement Theology; those involved in the New Apostolic Reformation, and in many cases, those in the Charismatic camp (which seems to be the queen over the others), all claim to have replaced Israel as a national entity.

If people choose to displace the Jewish nation and take on the blessings of the Abrahamic covenant, then they have to naturally take on the penalties that Israel paid when it was disobedient. If the claims of these groups are correct, then they inherit the good and the bad. Let's look at a simple example, and that example is identity theft. Let's say that someone is able to assume an identity in such a way that they take over their victim's bank account and their home. As far as anyone is concerned, the thieves become the people they have replaced. The

thieves enjoy the home and are spending the bank accounts down to nothing. However, problems arise. The house has a bad deteriorating foundation, the plumbing is getting old and leaking and the wiring is in danger of burning down the house. The thieves have inherited those problems. Then, one day the IRS delivers a letter to the thieves (who, remember have assumed the original person's identity) telling them that they haven't paid taxes in years and that they will now lose everything that they own. All of a sudden it seems that throwing the other's out and assuming their identity isn't so much fun. The blessings were fun to live under, but the curses are not.

Okay, so we know that there were things that Israel was commanded to obey. If they obeyed they would be blessed and if they were disobedient, then there were consequences. For instance, Israel was told that every 7th year would be a Shimitah Year. In that year they would let the fields grow fallow and would not plant on it. Israel disobeyed, and they went into captivity for it. Israel was supposed to observe Jubilee Years every 50th year. It was a time when slaves were freed, and debts were forgiven. When Israel obeyed, they were blessed and when they disobeyed, they were corrected.

There were other things that Israel was commanded to do. One thing was to keep Shabbat and revere that day as holy. Jews to this day keep Shabbat because they know that YHVH commanded that from sundown on Friday night to sundown on Saturday night, Israel was commanded to rest. Israel was also commanded to keep Pesach (Passover) perpetually, forever. Each year Jews around the world observe Pesach. YHVH commanded that Israel observe His feasts, perpetually and forever. Each year, Jews all over the world keep the feasts. However, those who have chosen to supplant themselves over Physical Israel have violated all of these

things. Under the guise that Grace destroys and abolishes the Torah, these people disregard Pesach, Shabbat and the Feasts, calling all of these things obsolete.

Now, if YHVH gave instructions for those who chose to call themselves Israel had to keep these days and feasts “perpetually,” and “forever,” he meant it. Nowhere in the Hebrew texts of the Tanakh does it say “you will observe these things until I abolish them...” He never said that they would be observed until something else would replace them; forever is forever. That is, unless without the knowledge of anyone earth was plunged into another universe, another reality after the death of Yeshua on the cross. And what about Yeshua’s statement that said that the Torah would abide until the end of heaven and earth:

Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:17-20

The scripture above states that the Torah is still in effect. Yes, I will agree that Yeshua provided atonement and did abolish the Law of Sin and Death. But the Ten Commandments are part of the Law, so did Yeshua nail the Ten Commandments to the Cross? The Torah is needed to show people what they are forgiven from and it is given as a moral guideline to show people

what is right and wrong. If it isn't in affect anymore, how do we know if we sin? Answer, we don't. If a person is born again, they still live in a body of flesh, and flesh is corrupt, so, even regenerated people need the Law so that the Ruach Ha Kodesh can use it to show us where we have transgressed YHVH's wants and desires for our lives. When people say that the Torah is dead, and that it is replaced by Grace, they are saying that there is no more Law, and where there no law, there is anarchy. Gee, isn't that what we see within the Church currently? We see leaders and their followers falling into doctrines of demons.

Recently, a pastor and his family died in a plane crash in the Bahamas. We found out later that the pastor believed and taught that there was no sin and hell and that Yeshua never died on the cross. There are Dominionists running around saying that they want to take back the world for Yeshua so that when he returns, they can present his with His godly Kingdom. That is so anti-Biblical and Antichrist that anyone that studies the Bible and has the Ruach Ha Kodesh within them can see it for what it is.

When we're talking about the New Apostolic Reformation we come into a sticky wicket, so to speak. The NAR is like the mother-ship of all movements like Dominionism and Replacement Theology. They all seem to be intertwined within each other. Many fault the NAR because of they cling to the Five Fold Ministry that is found in Ephesians:

And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ Ephesians 4:11-13

These offices were given by Mashiach so that the Body of Mashiach would grow. This only works however when the five offices work together. The problem is that even though we're born again and we're new creatures, our flesh often gets in the way and we establish a pecking order or hierarchy that places importance of one thing over the other or others. The Five-Fold ministry is a fivefold check and balance system in its true form. The NAR however places emphasis on the Apostles and Prophets as being the leaders of the church. They see it sort of like a chess board; the king and queen are more important than the rooks, bishops, knights and the lowly pawns. If a pawn is given a prophetic word for the king, the pawn is seen as being disobedient and acting in a sinful manner and is corrected and/or put out of the church. Yeshua was quite clear that we're not supposed to seek the better seat, but that the greatest amongst us should be servant to the least.

Let's look at the tenets of NAR to see where they are in error. Here is a little overview of the NAR:

The New Apostolic Reformation is a title originally used by C. Peter Wagner to describe a movement within Pentecostal and charismatic churches. The title New Apostolic Reformation is descriptive of a theological movement and is not an organization and therefore does not have formal membership. Among those in the movement that inspired the title NAR, there is a wide range of variance on specific beliefs. Those within the movement hold to their denominational interpretations of the ongoing ministry of the Holy Spirit within each believer. Unlike some parts of Protestant Christianity, these include the direct revelation of Christ to each believer, prophecy, and the performance of

miracles such as healing. This move has also been given the descriptive title, the Third Wave of the Holy Spirit.

Wagner has listed the differences between the NAR and traditional Protestantism as follows:

- *Apostolic governance – The Apostle Paul’s assertion that Jesus appoints apostles within his church continues to this day.*
- *The office of the prophet – There is within the church a role and function for present-day prophets.*
- *Dominionism – “When Jesus came, He brought the kingdom of God and He expects His kingdom-minded people to take whatever action is needed to push back the long-standing kingdom of Satan and bring the peace and prosperity of His kingdom here on earth.”*
- *Theocracy – Not to be confused with theocratic government but rather the goal to have “kingdom-minded people” in all areas of society. There are seven areas identified specifically: religion, family, education, government, media, arts & entertainment, and business.*
- *Extra-biblical revelation – There is available to all believers the ability to hear from God. “The one major rule governing any new revelation from God is that it cannot contradict what has already been written in the Bible. It may supplement it, however.*
- *Supernatural signs and wonders – Signs and wonders such as healing, demonic deliverance and confirmed prophecies accompany the move of God.*

- *Relational structures – church governance has no formal structure but rather relational and voluntary alignment to apostles.*

Though few organizations publically espouse connection to the NAR, there are several individuals often associated with this movement including:

- *Lou Engle – Founder of The Call*
- *Mike and Cindy Jacobs – Founders of Generals International*
- *Bill Johnson – Head Pastor of Bethel Church*
- *Rick Joyner – Founder of Morning Star Ministries*
- *Rafael Cruz, pastor and father of Sen. Ted Cruz*
- *C. Peter Wagner – Founder of Global Harvest Ministries*

According to Wagner, “The second apostolic age began in the year 2001” when the lost offices of prophet and apostle were restored.

I do believe in the office of Apostle and think that it's valid for today. Paul was an Apostle as were the other disciples. Apostles often established churches and taught righteousness to the churches. They rebuffed churches when there was sin. The problem that exists within the NAR is that there is a group of elites that appoints and delegates the office of Apostle, and it isn't YHVH that is doing this within the NAR.

Another thing that isn't quite Kosher with the NAR and their apostles is that there seems to be a “good old boys club” within the apostolic body. This is very similar to the Nicolaitans,

the people whose practice that Yeshua hated. It is also reminiscent of the Vatican which has a body of cardinals who appoint cardinals and those in lower offices, and of course the Popes.

Yet another thing that is bothersome is, if these apostles are “watchers,” over the church, who is watching the watchers? Who are they accountable to? One could say that they are accountable to YHVH, but when you read about some of the practices and beliefs of these supposed “apostles,” one can see that it is a loosely knit cabal of people who agree to work with each other as long as each apostle is allowed to operate in their own way and not be corrected by the others.

Take for instance Bill Johnson, the Head Pastor of Bethel Church in Redding California. Johnson’s church is known to be a hyper-Charismatic church. “Hyper” in the Greek language means “above.” It can also be used to denote faster, as in hypersonic which means above the speed of sound. In essence, his church is Charismatic on steroids. Johnson believes in something called Grave Sucking. What is grave sucking you ask?

Grave sucking or mantle grabbing is the belief and practice of pulling the supposed Holy Spirit powers from the dead bones of a previously empowered believer. It is taught that when a Spirit empowered individual dies their mantle or mission dies with them. In other words God’s mission for that believer was thwarted when that believer died.

In the words of Bill Johnson himself:

“There are anointings, mantles, revelations and mysteries that have lain unclaimed, literally where they were left because the generation that walked in them never passed them on. I believe it’s possible for us to recover realms of anointing, realms of insight, realms of God that have been untended for decades simply by choosing to reclaim them and perpetuate them for future generations.”

Benny Hinn believes in Grave Sucking too:

I felt a terrific anointing when I was there. I actually, I—I, hear this, I trembled when I visited Aimee’s tomb. I was shaking all over. God’s power came all over me. ... I believe the anointing has lingered over Aimee’s body. I know this may be shocking to you. ... And I’m going to take David [Palmquist] and Kent [Mattox] and Sheryl [Palmquist] this week. They’re gonna come with me. You—you—you gonna feel the anointing at Aimee’s tomb. It’s incredible. And Kathryn’s. It’s amazing. I’ve heard of people healed when they visited that tomb. They were totally healed by God’s power. You say, ‘What a crazy thing.’ Brother, there’s things we’ll never understand. Are you all hearing me?” *[Source: <http://youthapologeticstraining.com/grave-sucking/>]*

Okay, so where does this grave sucking idea come from. It is taken from one scripture, yes, only one scripture and it is twisted into a modern-day application:

And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band of men; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet. 2 Kings 13:21

So, from one scripture we get this bizarre and totally unscriptural practice of grave sucking. Imagine, stating that a person died before their residual Holy Spirit mantle was used up. Isn't that saying that the person died before YHVH wanted them to die? YHVH numbers our days, that is scriptural and to say that he gave more of a measure of the Ruach than a person needed is saying that YHVH doesn't know what he's doing or when a person is going to die. And what about necromancy? Necromancy is calling up the spirits of the dead. It was what Saul was guilty of and ultimately lead to his death and his losing his anointing as King of Israel. Calling anything up from a grave, even if it is the supposed overdose of the Ruach Ha Kodesh that is left on the person can only be described as witchcraft. IF a pastor (oh, excuse me, apostle) allows witchcraft to thrive in his church(s) and he teaches that the practice of witchcraft is valid and sanctioned by YHVH, then he is a false apostle, a false shepherd and a false prophet.

Now one has to ask one question. Since Bill Johnson is in such error, why isn't he corrected? In the early church there were constant corrections. Paul corrected Peter, right? And, to confirm that Paul was correct, YHVH sent down the sheet of clean and unclean animals and asked Peter to eat. This was used as an illustration from YHVH confirming that the Goyim were allowed in the Church and that they didn't have to convert to Judaism to be part of YHVH's flock. So why aren't Wagner, Engel, Jacobs, Joyner (who is supposedly a prophet too), and Cruz performing a Matthew 18 process against Johnson? Well, could it be it is because they all believe in the witchcraft of Soul Sucking? As I said before, who is watching the watchers?

What do some of the other bigwigs of the NAR Movement believe? Let's look:

“Lou Engle and Mike Bickle go hand in hand both working closely together for the same goals. Lou spreads the false doctrine of Joel's Army and the Manifest Sons of God (who teach that the rise of a victorious church of “overcomers” endowed with supernatural power to wage spiritual warfare and perform miracles would usher in the second coming of Christ). He also teaches that an end-time army engaged in spiritual warfare will take dominion over the earth.”

Rick Joyner: “This guy is probably the biggest false prophet out of Kansas City, he uses his prophecy to discourage people from looking into the truth and promotes the dominion agenda. One of the biggest giveaways for this guy is that he is part of a Masonic organization called the Knights of Malta. It is admitted right on his website since he had no way to hide it. David Rockefeller – a leader in the NWO – is also a part of this group. The knights of Malta is a Masonic order underneath the Roman Catholic Church.”

Paul Cain and Bob Jones: “Here are 2 other guys that are considered as head Prophets for the movement. They have numerous false prophecies, and both claim to have visions of angels and heaven visitations. Paul Cain claimed that Jesus appeared to him while driving in his car and told him that he (Jesus) was jealous of his relationship with his soon to be wife and that if Cain wanted an intimate relationship with Jesus he had to remain celibate for the rest of his life. Cain was kicked out of ministry for being a homosexual and having a problem with alcohol. Bob Jones who also is a mentor of Bentley was discredited first for abusive harmful use of his prophetic gifting than it came

out that he was sexually abusing women by telling them they needed to be naked before God and to undress in front of him. Bob Jones still is part of the Kansas City prophets and releases words on the Elijah list. Yes, people these are the head Apostles and Prophets that the whole world-wide church is expected to submit to.”

Mike Bickle and IHOP: “Mike is the founder of this group coming up from under John Wimber and Vineyard. This is the driving force behind the whole prayer/spiritual warfare movement encompassing many groups. It is an interesting fact that Vineyard was the vehicle for these movements, but they have now become disassociated with both the Toronto Blessings and Mike Bickle. Mike claims to have heard an audible voice of the Lord to start this movement and make claims of going to heaven, having visions and seeing angels. Most cults have started in the exact same way, people having a “spiritual” experience and claim that it validates everything they do. Augustine Acolla was the person who gave him the confirming prophetic word to start his movement, but this person was discredited with false prophecies and for being a homosexual. Bickle is the forerunner for a lot of the mystic ideas such as “contemplative prayer” and “harp & bowl” type of intercession. On top of that he has many false doctrines he promotes such as the Manifest Sons of God. There are many reports of his IHOP being very cultic, even abusive, and people have reported seeing many people with Masonic rings in the prayer room there. One person was even murdered for opposing IHOP and a baby was starved to death through fasting.”

Kansas City Prophets and Elijah's List: "This group is responsible for polluting the church with many false books and prophecies. They are spreading a false deceptive prophetic mantle out over the church and catching many well-meaning people up in it that have had genuine prophetic gifting. What typically happens is that someone with a genuine prophetic gifting will start looking to these guys as examples, read their books and their prophecies. Soon they start adopting the way they prophecy and get caught up in this deceptive stream of prophecy. This deceptive stream works like this: After someone has started reading the books, going to the meetings of these "prophets" and getting things imparted to them they start to use the same prophetic lingo as everyone else. Then (from what they heard) their imaginations dream up things that seem to fit the vision of what these guys have been prophesying about.

Now the trouble with this is these people are being taught mostly to use pictures in their imagination and dreams to prophecy – the Devil can send deceptive spirits to influence this type of prophecy. Some people who are under these guys do really hear from God, even with the influence of these people they still prophecy according to God. But many people start to drift and speak some truth and some things out of their imagination. Others get caught right up in it and may have never even had the gift (because they don't even know what the genuine is) and start prophesying according to the counterfeit.

The modern church has completely underestimated the danger of this movement. Most of these prophets use prophetic lingo that sounds really good but are very vague and immeasurable where they cannot be held accountable. When they do say something

measurable most of the time it is wrong, and they make excuses like the “modern-day prophet only has to be a certain percentage right, no one is perfect”. In the Bible they killed people who made false prophecy.”

As I mentioned earlier, this NAR is the umbrella for many things, including Dominionism. In a nutshell here is what dominionism is. The doctrine states that Yeshua brought the Kingdom of YHVH to earth. It is the believer’s duty to infiltrate all forms of earthly subdomains, such as religion, politics and many other things in order to get the world nice and pretty, and in line with the Kingdom so that when Yeshua returns, the world is perfect for him. So much for Yeshua saying, “if time were not shortened no flesh would survive,” and he was talking about His return. I believe the words of Yeshua, and His words make the NAR notion of dominionism look so stupid that it isn’t worth much more mention.

The NAR says that extra-biblical revelation is fine, as long as it can be confirmed by scripture. They do however add another sentence to their statement where extra-biblical revelation is concerned, “*It may supplement it, however.*” Supplement is a very interesting word, and its definition creates many loopholes for the NAR gang:

Supplement:

A. Something that completes or makes an addition.

B. A part added to or issued as a continuation of a book or periodical to correct errors or make additions.

This creates quite a problem-child if we're going to use extra-biblical revelations to "supplement" Biblical Scripture. We know that the Bible is complete in its present form. So, we can't do anything to complete it, and if someone tries to complete it then they negate that the truth that the Bible is complete. Since Scripture is complete, we're not to make any additions to it; that is an ultimate no-no and the practice thereof is heresy.

The second definition is similar. Scripture is complete and cannot be added to. All of the books of Scripture are finished, and continuations are not allowed nor are they to be condoned. The Bible is the Word of YHVH, so therefore it is flawless and perfect, and there are no errors so how can extra-biblical revelation can correct something that is perfect? It cannot. And again, it is complete, so no additions are needed. The fact that NAR says that extra-biblical revelation can be used to supplement scripture means that they are saying that they can use new revelation to tweak scripture to meet their needs. That seems to be the modus-operandi of every cult or cult-like organization or movement, isn't it?

The NAR states that it wants to create a theocracy. A theocracy is great if YHVH is at its head, and that will happen when Yeshua returns. Theocracy's have been attempted before and they are currently being attempted. Have you ever heard of The Holy Roman Empire, ruled by the Roman Catholic Church? It was not a wonderful thing, run by men who called themselves "godly" but who were also responsible for the deaths of upwards of 70 million "real" Christians (Protestants, Huguenots and such). That didn't work out so well, did it? In our current time Islam is increasing their efforts to establish a worldwide Caliphate where you accept Islam as your religion, or you are a slave, or you die. That's not working out so well, and we haven't seen the

whole shebang established either. Is there no wonder why the Muslim News Service, Al Jazeera, has dubbed the NAR “Christianity’s Taliban?”

The NAR states that it believes in supernatural signs and wonders. I do too, and I have seen my share of such things. However, NAR endorses people like Todd Bentley, a vile man that heals people (supposedly) by punching them in various places and slamming them down to the ground. Interestingly, Todd claims to have had a supernatural experience where he said he was laying on a table and angels were operating on him and placing things into him. That sounds exactly like the description of an alien abduction scenario. Perhaps Bentley’s angels were disguised as good angels and he’s under the influence of fallen angels. I’d believe that before I would believe that he has any valid ministry from YHVH.

In addition, NAR also claims things like holy laughter, gold dust and precious gems being found during their services and angel feathers falling from heaven upon their congregants. One video online shows a pastor who brags that angels disguised as lighted orbs come to his services. The orbs can be seen on the video. However, what most fail to realize is that orbs are always associated with demonic and fallen angelic activity. So, the claims of the orbs being angels are probably right, but not the sort of angels I would want to appear in a genuine service dedicated to Yeshua. Anyone that has walked with Yeshua and has been Ruach filled for any amount of time knows that the things that the Ruach Ha Kodesh gives are not things that the world finds valuable; His gifts are eternal and spiritual in nature. Oh, and besides, regular angels don’t have wings, so where do the feathers really come from. Food for thought.

The NAR states that it believes in relational structures. In other words, the church is run by the Apostles/prophets and other offices are null and void, or under the strict hand of those

apostles and/or prophets. I got to see this first hand a few years ago. I went to a church that has a wonderful pastor. He is a genuine shepherd and a very godly man. I haven't met many people that love Yeshua like Tom Mooney does. In the congregation were four or five self-appointed prophets. The pastor took the prophets into the church leadership and made them elders, but they were mostly known as prophets. They wanted me to join them because of my prophetic office, but I always felt that something was wrong. After a couple of years (of my attendance) things started to get weird. I attended a few of the "prophet's" meetings and noticed that they would constantly mock the pastor. That bothered me. Toward the end of the supposed "prophet's" tenure at this church they tried to take over the church. They explained their belief that YHVH didn't recognize pastors anymore. A great move of YHVH happened in that they tried to persuade people to leave the church with them, but nobody left, only them, and the church was much better for it.

The NAR supports false shepherds that could be seen as evangelists that serve NAR's means. People the likes of Joel and Victoria Olsteen are one example. This sort gets people all wrapped up in Grace, and a lack of sin so that the sheep are lulled to sleep while the NAR elites are busy using them as mindless drones to accomplish their means. These drones are persuaded to vote a conservative/Christian ticket. Rick Perry is a big NAR figure and he never ran for president in 2016 but you can bet that the NAR mouthpieces would have promoted that "Christians" vote for him.

Another big NAR love-child is Rick Warren, who is trying to bring peace between Islam and Christianity, promoting what many are calling Christlam. Christlam is attempting to bring Yeshua to the Islamic world by watering down the Gospel so that Muslims will accept Yeshua,

thus fulfilling a great commission, but the result will be a watered-down Christianity that will meld with Islam to become The Woman with the cup full of martyr's blood.

The NAR is a large and complicated movement with hundreds if not thousands of tentacles that reach into every aspect of Christianity. They hate Jews, so they are rabidly anti-Israel, in that they want to claim the land of Israel for Christianity by displacing the Jews. It is easy to see how NAR is dangerous. They are militant and have just as much fervor as radical Islam. As I mentioned at the beginning of this article, if a group wants to replace physical Israel by claiming that it is the "real" physical or spiritual Israel, then they will have to take the blessings as well as the curses.

Most Christians will flat out tell you that they can't understand how Israel could be so rebellious; how they constantly worshiped idols and played the harlot. This coming from a people who have made our savior's birth a pagan festival and his resurrection a mockery by celebrating Ishtar (Easter). This coming from a people who name it and claim it while they pray for big cars, big houses, the highest employment positions and just about every worldly thing one could imagine. The Church has pointed a finger at everyone except themselves, so now they will suffer the same consequences that Israel suffered, and much worse because they should know better. In closing, look at Ezekiel 22 and see how the Christian Church parallels what YHVH said of Israel. A remnant will come out, but most will go down with the proverbial ship. Here is Ezekiel 22:

Moreover the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Now, thou son of man, wilt thou judge, wilt thou judge the bloody city? yea, thou shalt shew her all her abominations.

Then say thou, Thus saith the Lord God, The city sheddeth blood in the midst of it, that

her time may come, and maketh idols against herself to defile herself Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast defiled thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come even unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries. Those that be near, and those that be far from thee, shall mock thee, which art infamous and much vexed.

Behold, the princes of Israel, every one were in thee to their power to shed blood. In thee have they set light by father and mother: in the midst of thee have they dealt by oppression with the stranger: in thee have they vexed the fatherless and the widow. Thou hast despised mine holy things, and hast profaned my sabbaths. In thee are men that carry tales to shed blood: and in thee they eat upon the mountains: in the midst of thee they commit lewdness. In thee have they discovered their fathers' nakedness: in thee have they humbled her that was set apart for pollution. And one hath committed abomination with his neighbour's wife; and another hath lewdly defiled his daughter in law; and another in thee hath humbled his sister, his father's daughter. In thee have they taken gifts to shed blood; thou hast taken usury and increase, and thou hast greedily gained of thy neighbours by extortion, and hast forgotten me, saith the Lord God. Behold, therefore I have smitten mine hand at thy dishonest gain which thou hast made, and at thy blood which hath been in the midst of thee. Can thine heart endure, or can thine hands be strong, in the days that I shall deal with thee? I the Lord have spoken it, and will do it. And I will scatter thee among the heathen, and disperse thee in the countries, and will

consume thy filthiness out of thee. And thou shalt take thine inheritance in thyself in the sight of the heathen, and thou shalt know that I am the Lord.

And the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Son of man, the house of Israel is to me become dross: all they are brass, and tin, and iron, and lead, in the midst of the furnace; they are even the dross of silver. Therefore thus saith the Lord God; Because ye are all become dross, behold, therefore I will gather you into the midst of Jerusalem. As they gather silver, and brass, and iron, and lead, and tin, into the midst of the furnace, to blow the fire upon it, to melt it; so will I gather you in mine anger and in my fury, and I will leave you there, and melt you. Yea, I will gather you, and blow upon you in the fire of my wrath, and ye shall be melted in the midst thereof. As silver is melted in the midst of the furnace, so shall ye be melted in the midst thereof; and ye shall know that I the Lord have poured out my fury upon you.

And the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Son of man, say unto her, Thou art the land that is not cleansed, nor rained upon in the day of indignation. There is a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst thereof, like a roaring lion ravening the prey; they have devoured souls; they have taken the treasure and precious things; they have made her many widows in the midst thereof. Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine holy things: they have put no difference between the holy and profane, neither have they shewed difference between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them. Her princes in the midst thereof are like wolves ravening the prey, to shed blood, and to destroy souls, to get dishonest gain. And her prophets have daubed them with untempered mortar, seeing vanity, and divining lies

unto them, saying, Thus saith the Lord God, when the Lord hath not spoken. The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully. And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none. Therefore have I poured out mine indignation upon them; I have consumed them with the fire of my wrath: their own way have I recompensed upon their heads, saith the Lord God. Ezekiel 22:1-31

CHAPTER TWO

BETHEL REDDING, NAR, MORMONISM IN THESE LAST DAYS

Introduction:

When we started the Delusion Resistance Ministry back around 1999 we had initially started it in response to the Heaven's Gate suicide in California, where adherents to Marshall Applewhite's cult took their lives thinking that they would be whisked away by a UFO travelling in the tail of the comet Hale-Bopp. Back in those days we were concerned about any and all heresies that were out there, both secular and religious. Yes, there were charlatans like Kenneth Copeland and Robert Tilton et.al running around, but their doctrine was so far out there that those who followed Yeshua saw the heresy for what it was. Up until then we thought that if any deception were to deceive the church it would be a worldly deception that the Body of Mashiaich would take unto itself. We saw in Yeshua's warning about deception, that He was referring to His followers falling for worldly wisdom, outright. And again, yes, we did know that there were some who bought into men like Copeland, Hagin, Schuller and Tilton but we never thought that the false doctrine of these men and others would proliferate into churches and people who seemed to be so staunchly established on the Rock that is Yeshua.

We pressed on in an effort to educate people about things like the fallen angel incursion of Genesis chapter six and the Nephilim that lived during that time that were birthed to those fallen angels by human women. We delved into explaining what UFO's and aliens really are using a Biblical explanation and we excelled in this ministry only with the help of Yeshua's

Ruach Ha Kodesh. As time progressed we started to realize that there were many who were picking up on those things and they shared those things on the internet to the point that we felt that we had been given many children that would carry on that ministry, and to this day there is a myriad of teachers that do a fine job exposing the alien lie for what it is.

Both Jim Wilhelmsen and I received what we know to be a change in direction where ministry is concerned. Around 2011 we started to feel impressed that with all of the people talking about Nephilim and the Sons of God we should look ahead to preparing people to know what to do when all of prophetic things start to come about. Any good plan for protection should have a contingency plan or what to do when the danger actually approaches. Yes, many of us are called to be watchmen on the city wall, but when we see the enemy coming then what? Do we sit on the wall and continually say that the enemy is coming, or do we jump off the wall to help our city to prepare to shore up the gate and gather the tools of war? Yet there had to be a time when the city fathers gathered to make plans for any threat that might come from outside.

With that knowledge, Jim and I decided that we needed to help people to be ready for the coming melee that will soon come upon the earth and that will impact the church like never before. Yes, it is important to know who the enemy is, but it is equally important to know the tactics of the enemy and what the enemy's weaknesses are. It is equally important to know how each of us will be responsible to our commander (Yeshua) and how we are to conduct ourselves. It is my opinion and belief that when the defecation hits the rotary oscillator there will be four groups of people, three groups of believers and one group of those who we thought were believers. There will be those who will participate in physical combat with the enemy, and those people will do that because that is what they are called to do. There will also be those who are

called to head to the hills and hide out, and that will be their calling. In addition, there will be those who will not take up arms but will be witnesses who fight through spiritual means. Finally, there will be those who will either through ignorance or fear turn themselves over to join with the enemy. My suspicion is that the last group will be large in number.

In an effort to spread our message we started a blog radio broadcast. As with any message, it is the responsibility of the messenger to use any means possible to get the message out to those who need to hear it. In 2011 Jim and I started the Opposing the Matrix radio show. For the first four years we aired on Blog Talk Radio, but broadcast quality was never good and that particular format has other undesirable issues. In 2014 our brother Randal Mann offered us airtime on his radio format and we started working with him. He still archives our shows at his GWOW Radio site. After five years Jim stepped down to pursue other ministry interests and now our good friend Kristin Peterson has taken on the mantle of cohost. Kristin feels an urgency to help believers in Yeshua to understand what YHVH requires of his people and also to expose heresies that have implanted themselves with the Body of Mashiach. Now that I have explained a little about our Opposing the Matrix ministry, and our focus, please allow me to elaborate below in regard to one area of focus.

Bethel Church in Redding and Bill Johnson It's Pastor:

You know it seems that I'm some sort of heretic magnet. All of my life I have been led to churches with problems (except for one in California) and I've had to address those problems much to the consternation of those in leadership. It usually leads to me being asked to leave or

being kicked out of the fellowship. However recently, I've been led to people who are in the clutches of such churches. These people are not strangers, but friends and family. It is not uncommon for friends and family to take on the herd mentality whereby they go along with things that they hear, and they fall into the trap where they accept what they hear and are not willing to discern or investigate everything by comparing it to scripture and using it as a litmus test for truth.

I sometimes will try to stomach television evangelists by watching them for a short time. When I watch the charlatans, it bothers me that they are allowed to speak false doctrines, but what I find most grievous is when I see the people in the audience shaking their heads in agreement and shouting amen or hallelujah to the lies that are being presented to them. What is more heartbreaking than that is when I turn on Facebook and I see relatives and/or friends quoting from these charlatans and/or the quotes of those in other religions. It is just for this reason; that relatives post things from Bethel Church, that I felt spurred on to do a study into the beliefs of the Church body and of course the pastor.

As I said above I have a vested interest in some of these things because loved ones are drawn some of these heretical churches and/or pastors. The enigma with the Charismatic movement is that they started out with great intentions. I once called myself a Charismatic believer. Their weirdness caused me to grow together with other movements and/or titles. Like I said, the Charismatic movement started out in a wonderful day when people were asking Yeshua to endow His believers with more of the Ruach Ha Kodesh. We enjoyed the three plus hours of worship time and the way that we felt when the YHVH's Ruach fell on us in mighty ways.

The problem is that people started to seek the feelings and experience of Yeshua's Ruach and less of Him. Yes, experience is enjoyable, but it can become like a drug, addictive. When we start to seek the experience and/or feelings and when we try to "call up" the giver of the Ruach in order to get the feeling and/or experience then there is a big problem. Yeshua called the Ruach Ha Kodesh the "Comforter," because comfort is needed in time of stress and anguish. Yeshua said that the Ruach Ha Kodesh would lead us in all righteousness and that He would help us to understand in a better way the God that we are serving. Yeshua NEVER said that we could call upon the Ruach to perform miracles, to show us signs and wonders and to be our genie to grant our every wish. Those are practices that Wiccan's perform; they summon the spirits to perform magic, signs and miracles.

Now I'm not saying that everything in the Charismatic movement is bad. Like any work of YHVH, it is pure until mankind starts to meddle with the workings that YHVH has set in motion. I do believe in the Five-Fold Ministry, but only when YHVH administers it. I do believe in healings, in miracles and speaking in tongues, as long as those things are orchestrated by Yeshua and His Ruach. Sometimes people forget that there is rank in the things of YHVH. Aveinu puts all things in Yeshua's charge, who in turn sends the Ruach Ha Kodesh to minister and finally there are YHVH's servants (that's the People of YHVH). When we pray we pray to Aveinu, in Yeshua's name and prayers are answered according to how they fit into YHVH's will. We DO NOT proclaim things and wait for YHVH to answer because neither you nor I know His will and the order in which He wants to administer His will.

So, when I hear or see online Bill Johnson or any of his cronies spout their NAR Dominionism or when I hear of Mantle Snatching (aka grave sucking), or when I see a video of Shawn Bolz at

“Azusa Now” just a few weeks ago practicing witchcraft by calling out names that what he claims to be the Holy Spirit is giving him on his text phone, I grow concerned.

You see, our relatives that talk about things that churches like Bethel is doing or pastor’s like Bill John is doing because they either will not or just do not look into the whole story. Yes, there are the fluffy little stories about healings and other miracles that circulate, but the heretical and satanic stuff is kept in the dark from our loved ones. I have presented things to friend and loved ones only to get the classic answer that “well, God is working there so how can these things be?” That is a valid question, it really is. However, YHVH can work anywhere but it doesn’t mean that he condones or approves everything that is going on.

The Book of Daniel was written during Yehuda’s exile in one of the most pagan societies that ever existed, yet YHVH didn’t approve of the hedonistic and heathen society of Babylon. And, knowing that there are counterfeit spirits out there, like the Kundalini spirit that mimics the Ruach Ha Kodesh in so many ways, who is to say that the Ruach Ha Kodesh is really performing those miracles? When I see people flopping around on the floor of a service at Bethel, like they are fish out of water and they appear drunk and/or are speaking in all sorts of gibberish (I’m talking about fake tongues) I cannot attribute that to the real Ruach Ha Kodesh. If it looks Kundalini, smells Kundalini and manifests as Kundalini it is no doubt Kundalini.

Recently, I’ve done some research into the antics of Rick Joyner. This man claims to be a prophet of YHVH, but he is consistently wrong in his prophetic utterance. When his “predictions” turn out to be false they are either spiritualized or they are swept under the carpet with the excuse that he’s just a man and people are sometimes wrong. Well, yes, people are often

wrong, but if someone claims to get a message from YHVH Yeshua it cannot be wrong. Wrong message means no message from Yeshua Ha Mashiach, plain and simple.

On top of that, Joyner had the audacity to place a prophetic mantle on none other than Glenn Beck, a MORMON. Prophets of YHVH DO NOT place any sort of Godly thing on any unbeliever, or pseudo-believer. Mormons are not Biblical Christians, and never will be until they repent and accept the Messiah of the Bible. Furthermore, Joyner endorsed Mitt Romney for president when Romney ran back in 2012. Joyner said that he hoped that Romney would be the fulfillment of the Mormon “White Horse Prophecy,” which says that when the US Constitution seems to be in peril, a Mormon will raise up and take the country back for YHVH. However, they fail to mention that it is the Mormon Jesus that they will represent, not Yeshua Ha Mashiach.

Joyner, the NAR’s high chieftain of prophets doesn’t appear to know that when you’re sold out for Yeshua, you’re sold out entirely for Yeshua, not as it pleases you or as it might make you seem like a viable prophet. In my opinion, men like Rick Joyner and Bill Johnson are some of the most dangerous deceivers that there are, but they are highly praised by Christians who refuse to do their homework about the current Charismatic movement and its evolution into becoming the bastard child for the NAR and all of its wicked tentacles.

About 18 months ago, Ted Cruz was running to be the Republican nominee for President of the United States. Little do people know that Glenn Beck has endorsed Cruz. Don’t forget that Beck wears a false prophetic mantle placed on him by Big Chief Joyner. Another thing that eludes many Christians is that Ted Cruz’s father, Rafael Cruz is a big player in the NAR movement, quite the dominionist who actually proclaimed that YHVH himself has anointed Ted

Cruz to become the Messiah that will save our nation. It is not certain what office Rafael Cruz holds in the NAR but seeing that it was a prophet's job to anoint other prophets and Kings we can assume that the NAR considers him a prophet.

What is alarming being that the NAR that is growing into a cult on an almost daily basis with its rewriting the meaning of scripture and all of the strange doctrines and manifestations that present at their services. In addition, we have the Mormon church that is playing along with the NAR in ways like I never expected to see. Any believer in Yeshua that has done any study knows that Mormonism is a cult. They teach that Jesus and Lucifer were brothers, that god is flesh and blood and spends all of his time in perpetual sex with his uncountable wives on a planet orbiting a star named Kolob (pronounced ka-loob). They believe that you can baptize your unsaved relatives (unsaved by their terms) out of Mormon purgatory and into the celestial Mormon realm. And finally, they believe in crazy prophecies and rules that can be changed if they do not fit into what Mormonism currently believes.

Combine that with the NAR that perverts the Five-Fold Ministry doctrine and sets up something much akin to the Nicolaitan order of things. Yeshua hated the Nicolaitans. Add to that the belief that there can be extra-biblical prophetic utterance and that you can do things like suck left over holy spirit from dead believers, accept false prophecy as being new or excuse it as being "spiritual," and not literal and give spiritual gifts to those that adhere to religions opposed to the Gospel of Yeshua Ha Mashiach, and you have two forces combining that can in effect merge and feed off of each other, both vying to become the world's body what will govern every aspect of society, even your own thoughts and desires.

That is what people like Bill Johnson, Rick Joyner, Glenn Beck, Mitt Romney and yes, even Ted Cruz are up to. Mormons are out to produce a world full of Mormons that will present a perfect world to their god on Kolob. The NAR is out to make a perfect world to present to Yeshua when He returns to Earth. Neither of these plans and ideas are biblical, in fact they are both Antichrist in nature. It sort of makes you wonder if prophecy will play out like we've been led to believe all of these years; with a religious system that is run by the Vatican, or if it will actually be a melding of Mormonism and/or the NAR to be the Whore of Babylon that sits on seven mountains. Oh, and if you think that this is freaky, the NAR says that they want to take over SEVEN areas of society that they call their "Seven Mountain Theology."

I'm never advocated a vote for Ted Cruz, I was always mindful that he's not a clean as he's made out to be. Saying that he'd run down Donald Trump with a car, is that something that a staunch believer in Yeshua would say? Like we would say back in the 70's, "where's the love man."

CHAPTER THREE

CHRISTALIGNMENT, CHRISTIAN TAROT AND ANGELS' SPEAK BOARDS

Just when you think that the heretics at Bethel Church in Redding couldn't get more abominable, enter a new practice that shows them even more immersed in the New Age than ever before. I'm not saying that Bethel is the only abomination that is promoting what I am about to present, but it seems that Bethel presents itself as the upturned ground that every seed of deception falls into whereupon Bethel waters and tends the garden.

It is fairly easy to discern a Laodicean Church from the real Body of Mashiach because the real body of believers spurns worldly processes. Let me explain. A natural process of nature is that opposite forces attract each other and that like forces repel each other. The Kingdom of YHVH works differently like forces are attracted to one another and opposite forces repel each other. So, when a supposed "church" goes out of its way to take on the things of this world and they go through stringent efforts to promote worldly things you know that they are a tree that bears bad fruit.

The whole Bible is summed up like this. Mankind is in a fallen state and everyone is born a sinner, it is in our genetic makeup. YHVH brought the Torah (Instruction) to show us what offends him and what keeps us from having direct communion with him. In Torah, YHVH shows us what the problem is, and how people could fend off the penalty of sin, not abolish it, but to keep it away until something perfect could take it away. He instituted a list of things to do

and things not to do, and if a person could keep them, or reasonably try to keep them then at one-point YHVH would step in to fulfill the agreement that he instituted. It's sort of like a mortgage, a bank agrees to sell you a house and you can live in that house while you make payments and not until that last payment is made can you call the house truly your own, and the title only becomes yours when the bank stamps the mortgage "paid in full." Yes, you can make all of the payments, but until the lender is satisfied the house does not become yours.

We had a system where animals were sacrificed because YHVH dictated that it was shed blood of animals that could satisfy him. This was paying the mortgage. At the right time in history, Yeshua became the Lamb of YHVH, the ultimate sacrifice to pay the mortgage in full. Yes, you no longer have to pay the bank for the home, but you still have to pay property taxes and insurance on the home and your neighbors appreciate when you keep your home and property in good working order because what you do affects all of those around you. You could compare those things to the parts of Torah that are still in effect. Also, because we live in a reality that is ruled by atrophy, you have to paint the home, replace the roof from time to time and you have to do all sorts of things to keep the home livable. Yes, the bank has stamped your obligation "paid in full" but there are still other things that need to be done, as illustrated above. Yes, it is true that with the mortgage payments gone you can forego the insurance and you can elect not to paint the home or put on a new roof, and you could probably live in the home for a year or two without paying property taxes, but all of the neglect that I just mentioned will catch up with you sooner or later.

You could even lose your house because of that neglect, but YHVH has promised you a better home in Heaven but there is a problem, in that the Torah told you what you needed to do

to make YHVH happy because it told you that the upkeep of the home (your life) through his precepts keeps you from allowing yourself to fall into disrepair. When you let your house fall to pieces because you didn't care about what He told you to do to keep it in good repair you were disobedient to the Torah (Instructions) that he gave to you. Many people say that those instructions were nailed to the Cross with Yeshua, therefore they are not valid anymore. Yeshua's answer to that is that although he paid off the mortgage, he wanted you to obey all of those other things and although His Word is quite clear that many elements of Torah are valid still today, you chose to ignore that fact so that you could be foot-loose and fancy-free thinking that you can blackmail YHVH during the judgment by crying out, "well, you said we were under grace!" No, grace means "YHVH did it," and every covenant has two signing parties and His True People keep their part of the bargain by striving to obey the Ten Commandments and honoring Torah by not doing the things that YHVH said not to do and doing the things that YHVH told us to do.

What I originally did when this chapter was an article on the internet, was to present an audio of a video that I found on Youtube where a young man talks about Christian tarot reading. Since this is a book and not a webpage I cannot present that audio. However, I can talk about the highlights of the audio.

The first thing that I would like to point out is that no matter what YouTube video I found regarding this subject I have noticed that those spreading this lie are very young, in their teens and twenties and maybe a couple of people that are older, but for the most part they are Millennials in generational terms.

Angelo Nasios, the young person that made the video/audio had obviously been indoctrinated with the lie that the Tanakh (Old Testament) is a book that is only for the Jews and that it doesn't apply at all to Christians. It is because of his claim that I believe that he has probably never read scripture from the front to the back of the Bible and I can also make the determination that Angelo probably does not have a Born-Again relationship with Aveinu through Yeshua. People born of the Ruach Ha Kodesh have discernment and this kid did not seem to have any discernment. He seems to be parroting what he's heard, either from faulty teaching or from demons that speak to him directly.

Angelo went on to make claims that it is okay for people to give words of knowledge and prophecies that aren't necessarily in line with scripture. This makes me think that he's a disciple of NAR apostasy and it would be interesting to see if he's tied in with Bethel Church in Redding or one of their offshoots.

People who cling to abominations tend to state that what they do, they do is to help out the Ruach Ha Kodesh because these little heresies that they perform are easier to understand than the Words of YHVH that are imparted by the Ruach Ha Kodesh. Well yes, it is impossible for a natural man to understand the things of YHVH because they DO NOT have the Ruach to explain the mysteries of YHVH to them. Each and every time that a man (including this author) has attempted to "help YHVH" to do His work it has turned out badly. How many times YHVH has to pull us out of the fowler's snare because of our own ignorance only he can number. Because we cannot understand the purpose of YHVH in every circumstance we misinterpret when he does redeem our actions. He sometimes does make our mistakes fruitful because He is able to turn our mistakes around to use for His glory, but only at His timing, and only His timing.

When Angelo said that the Tanakh is no longer valid and that things are different in the New Testament I knew that his speech was going to be a spew of lies and deceit. He even quoted Deuteronomy 18, where YHVH forbids practices like divining through cards:

There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch. Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. Deuteronomy 18:10-11

Angelo went out of his way to state that divining was akin to words of knowledge and/or prophetic utterance which he is adamant is different in the New Testament period. What Angelo failed to talk about was the scripture directly before and after the scripture that he quoted:

When thou art come into the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. Deuteronomy 18:9

And:

For all that do these things are an abomination unto the Lord: and because of these abominations the Lord thy God doth drive them out from before thee. Thou shalt be perfect with the Lord thy God. Deuteronomy 18:12-13

I guess that this ignoramus never read the words of Paul that state:

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. Hebrews 13:8

The same voice that spoke to Moshe through the burning bush and on Mount Sinai is the same voice that spoke the Beatitudes at the Sermon on The Mount and he is the same person that said:

Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:17-19

First, we must examine what Yeshua meant when he says that He didn't come to destroy the Torah. If people like this kid were to look at the Greek words they would realize that "destroy," has a special meaning:

*Destroy: καταλύω katalýō, kat-al-oo'-o;
to dissolve, disunite*

1. *(what has been joined together), to destroy, demolish*
2. *metaph. to overthrow i.e. render vain, deprive of success, bring to naught*

A. to subvert, overthrow

- i. of institutions, forms of government, laws, etc., to deprive of force, annul, abrogate, discard*

3. *of travellers, to halt on a journey, to put up, lodge (the figurative expression originating in the circumstance that, to put up for the night, the straps and packs of the beasts of burden are unbound and taken off; or, more correctly from the fact that the traveller's garments, tied up when he is on the journey, are unloosed at it end)*

We can see that Yeshua is saying that He didn't come to annul or discard the Torah. I will also note that the third definition is interesting because it has to do with heavy loads and the word for "destroy" means to take that heavy load, which one could use Yeshua's own words to dispute, but it must be enforced that the Yoke and Burden that Yeshua was talking about in Matthew.

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. Matthew 11:28-30

Yeshua was in constant dialogue with the Scribes and Pharisees who taught Oral Tradition, sometimes referred to as Oral Law. That is why it has been written that Yeshua said, "it is written in your law," (Ref. John 8:17 and John 10:31) He wasn't criticizing the Torah, but the Oral Tradition that we know today as the Talmud, Mishna and other titles. These are a perversion of the Torah and/or commentaries of the Torah by men that gave their own thoughts on scripture. Even today, if you talk to Orthodox Rabbi's they will often quote from different Rabbi's and not so much from the Tanakh. So in essence, there is no contradiction because

Yeshua was saying that He didn't come to loosen the Torah from our lives, but he came to have us lay down the yoke and burden that oral tradition lays upon us.

Getting back to the word "destroy," it gets even better because as I have said in the past, in Hebrew, and in Greek a verb is always used to define a noun. In this case, the word "destroy," is a verb but it comes from an older verb λύω lýō, loo'-o; a primary verb, which means:

to loosen, undo, dissolve, anything bound, tied, or compacted together

1. *an assembly, i.e. to dismiss, break up*
2. *laws, as having a binding force, are likened to bonds*
3. *to annul, subvert*
4. *to do away with, to deprive of authority, whether by precept or act*
5. *to declare unlawful*
6. *to loose what is compacted or built together, to break up, demolish, destroy*
7. *to dissolve something coherent into parts, to destroy*
8. *metaph., to overthrow, to do away with*

We can see the root word for the verb "destroy," it still denotes that Yeshua didn't come to annul, or destroy, or declare unlawful or to dissolve the Torah. No, He said that he came to fulfill. Remember, He said that He did not come to do these things, He came to fulfill the Torah. So what about the Greek rendering of the word "fulfil?"

When we look at the scripture in Matthew we have to look at the word "fulfil," which is a key and the word "fulfilled," because it is the lock. Interestingly, they are two separate words in

the Greek, and probably were in the Hebrew original rendering. Let's look at the Greek word for "fulfil."

Fulfil: πληρώω plērōō, play-ro'-o;

1. to make full, to fill up, i.e. to fill to the full

A. to cause to abound, to furnish or supply liberally

i. I abound, I am liberally supplied

2. to render full, i.e. to complete

A. to fill to the top: so that nothing shall be wanting to full measure, fill to the brim

B. to consummate: a number

i. to make complete in every particular, to render perfect

ii. to carry through to the end, to accomplish, carry out, (some undertaking)

C. to carry into effect, bring to realisation, realise

i. of matters of duty: to perform, execute

ii. of sayings, promises, prophecies, to bring to pass, ratify, accomplish

iii. to fulfil, i.e. to cause God's will (as made known in the law) to be obeyed as it should be, and God's promises (given through the prophets) to receive fulfilment

Many non-Jews fail to realize that the word Torah doesn't mean "law" specifically, it is better rendered as "instruction." Basically, YHVH was saying, "This is what I like and what I do not like. If you love Me you will obey me, and if you do not obey me then ill will befall you." Many look at it as blessings and curses, but YHVH looks at it as the blessings of obedience and the consequences of disobedience. I mentioned earlier that Yeshua came to fulfill the Torah, not Oral Tradition.

When Yeshua was saying that He came to fulfill the Torah, He was saying that He came to complete it. We complete things every day, do we not? When a cook completes a cake by adding frosting and decorations the cake is displayed and later it is eaten. It has supplied delight to our eyes and satiated our want for cake. The cake went inside of us and its constituents became a part of us. When a car is fulfilled (completed) at the factory it is not destroyed, it is enjoyed by a new owner for several years and it is possible that it can be driven by many generations of a family if it is cared for and maintained correctly. In essence, after Yeshua's doing away with "the Law of Sin and Death" the Torah was made perfect because we can now live by it without fear of retribution or dread of failing YHVH, as long as we belong to Aveinu through Yeshua and we try in earnest to obey His Instruction.

Yeshua went on to say that The Torah will remain until Heaven and Earth pass away. The last time I looked that hasn't happened yet. He also said that that Torah would not pass away until all be fulfilled. Note that that word for "fulfil" and the word that we just examined are two different words. Let's look at the meaning:

Fulfilled: γίνομαι gínomai, ghin'-om-ahēe (pronounced genomi);

1. to become, i.e. to come into existence, begin to be, receive being

2. *to become, i.e. to come to pass, happen*

A. of events

3. *to arise, appear in history, come upon the stage*

A. of men appearing in public

4. *to be made, finished*

A. of miracles, to be performed, wrought

5. *to become, be made*

Simply put, Yeshua was saying that the Torah would remain until all is fulfilled, meaning that he was saying that until ALL is finished, the Torah will be in effect. The Torah is in effect because even though we have Grace offered to us, we still live in a fallen world and our flesh is subject to that degradation and corruption. But please allow me to go one step farther if you will?

In our current day, we hear the word “gene” mentioned in all sorts of conversations. Some people are into genetic studies to map the human genome while others are merely interested in researching their genealogy. I find it interesting that the word “gene” has Greek origins, and it is related to “genomi” that is used in scripture to mean fulfilled:

word-forming element technically meaning “something produced,” but mainly, in modern use, “thing that produces or causes,” from French -gène(18c.), from Greek -genes “born of, produced by,” related to genos “birth” (see genus). Originally in late 18th-century chemistry

and probably reflecting misunderstanding of -genes, as though it meant “that which produces.”

[Online Etymology Dictionary, © 2010 Douglas Harper]

The only place where we find an end to an old creation and the beginning of a new creation is when YHVH melts away the old Creation and afterward creates a New Heaven and New Earth. People might ask “why would we need a Torah when Yeshua returns?” Simple, he is returning to the old creation, the universe as it has been since He spoke it into existence, and although He paid the penalty for sin and death, the world will still be in a state of entropy, except for the idea that he will temporarily make Earth like it was before Adam and Chava transgressed in the Garden of Eden.

I do believe that the Torah will exist up until the time when a New Heaven and New Earth are created. Scripture is quite clear that when the New Heaven and New Earth are created, and the New Jerusalem is presented to the Earth there will no longer be sin and the new creation will be free from corruption and entropy. With no sin, there is no need for Torah because “we will all be like him.” This concept is enforced by the fact that Genomi in scripture means finished and the Greek origins of “gene” mean “thing that produces or causes,” and “thing born of.” When both words are used together it could be rendered:

“...until ALL be finished and something (Someone i.e. YHVH) causes a new thing to be born.”

Let's Get Off Of That Well Needed Rabbit Trail Shall We?

There is another audio to a video that I presented in the original article. It is produced by a young lady, I would say in her twenties, and she's quite skilled in adding just enough churchianity to make her sound like a believer, but the discerning eye/ear can make her out for who she is, just another confused New Age adherent that thinks she knows what Christianity is, but she falls far short.

What the young lady presented is a quite common interpretation of the use of magic being condoned in scripture as being a gift from YHVH. Before we begin, let affirm that she never presented the name Jesus or Yeshua mentioned once. That's odd because Yeshua is the one that sends the Ruach Ha Kodesh, the very Spirit that this woman said gives her interpretation. She used the generic word "god." Notice that I used a small "g" with the word YHVH because I truly do not think that she has communion with YHVH Elohim and I do believe that if she believes in Yeshua, it is the cosmic Jesus, not the Biblical Jesus.

Let me explain what I just said about Jesus. It was probably about 7 years ago that I received a call from a woman that wanted to contest my verifiable claim that the name of Jesus makes an alien abduction event stop and that a relationship with Aveinu through Yeshua causes all abduction experiences to end. The woman called and said emphatically, "you're wrong, I've tried your method several times and the abductions do not stop!" I was puzzled at first but then I heard YHVH tell me to ask her, "who do you think Jesus is?" She was quick to answer that Jesus is one of the cosmic heads of the universe and he is the head of the collective consciousness. Aha, I had the answer. I told her the reason why the "name" didn't work for her was that she was calling on a counterfeit Jesus, in fact, probably one of the fallen angels that are in league with the

entities that are abducting her. I quickly told her the Gospel of the real Jesus upon which time she hung up the phone.

We are told by Yeshua himself that in the Last Days there would be counterfeit Jesus' that would claim to be Him, but that we should not believe them. I told the woman above that what she was doing was akin to a Jew in Nazi Germany going to the local Gestapo office and asking them to protect them from Adolph Hitler. It was just not a viable or sensible choice and it would not work.

So, when the woman in the audio/video talked about God, and the Holy Spirit and she uses other catch words that Christians might recognize, she is lying AND she is presenting counterfeits that exist to deceive many, and will even try to deceive the Elite. Hopefully, when I say Elite, you are part of that group.

We know from an earlier part of this discussion that scripture forbids magic and divination among other things. So, the first warning signs are when people blame "Christian Culture" for not accepting magic and divination. Real believers that are filled with the Ruach Ha Kodesh, the original Ruach, have discernment and we know that Yeshua, the author of Scripture is "The same yesterday, today and forever." So, it isn't hard to know that if YHVH said that he found those who practice magic and divination and abomination in the Tanakh, we can be sure that these things abhor him not only in the Brit Hadasha period but even today. It is not only Christian culture that finds her practices offensive, it is also Torah adherent Jews and those of us who are Completed Jews that believe Yeshua.

With those things in mind, we know that it is impossible for the Bible to be “magical text,” a phrase that this woman uses several times. The woman calls herself a “Devout Christian,” but she avoids Christians in general because she states that she doesn’t go to church. Aside from popular opinion, there are churches that have real believers and although many churches today are apostate, not all are. My guess is that some discerning believers in at least one church knew about her magic and they tried to show her the truth, but she would not recant, and she left “offended” because as is evident from the audio/video, she possesses the truth and very few others do.

The woman stated that the Holy Spirit [sic] verifies things for her via personal confirmation. That is just another way of saying that something happened in her life, or someone came to her and told her something that her itching ears wanted to hear. It’s no different than an alcoholic saying that just another drink won’t hurt them or a heroin addict shooting up one more time because they’re not addicted. Both of those people heard a confirming voice too, right?

The woman mentioned several times that she loves Tarot and she loves Magic. Let me ask you something. Have you ever been in love with someone that you just have to date and/or marry? Remember how right it felt at the time and all of the confirmations that you received only to find out later that that person couldn’t be more wrong for you? If this woman was a truly Devout Christian, she would love Yeshua and she would obey His commandments. If she loved Yeshua and His Ruach resided in her she would flee from the very appearance of evil, both of which Magic and divination are.

In one of her rants, she says that she is in tune with the Ruach Ha Kodesh, and in the same rant she says that if the Ruach told her that Tarot and divination were wrong she would

sacrifice it because it would not be good for her walk with god. Yet again she says that the very voice that told Moshe that YHVH hates magic and divination is the one that says that magic and divination is okay for Christians to do. She says that is supposed to stay in alignment with the Ruach Ha Kodesh, but she cannot possibly be aligned with the Ruach, no, she is in fact diametrically opposed to the Ruach Ha Kodesh, meaning that she is in alignment with the Kundalini Spirit, not the Holy Spirit.

The woman stated that a Tarot is a tool and a guide. Of course, she would say that because she cannot say that the Holy Spirit led her to Scripture because Scripture would prove her to be a witch and/or Satanist. The trick is to get people out of the Bible because the Bible is the tool and guide that YHVH has His Ruach use to confirm revelation and prophecy. If a word or prophecy comes and it doesn't mesh with scripture, then it is junk. Let's face it, using the Tarot takes the power away from the Ruach Ha Kodesh and gives it to the person reading the Tarot, or the beings guiding the person that is reading the Tarot. Note that this woman was quick to disavow that demonic forces were behind Tarot and Magic, yet she says the source of these things come from unseen forces. Well, it's a no-brainer who those forces are.

I love it when she said that "god made me with love for magical things." News Flash, every person that has ever been born has been with a keen interest in unseen things. It is actually a growth process when we come to faith in Yeshua because we become "New Creatures," born of the Ruach Ha Kodesh after we have been born from our mothers. What would be funny, if it were not so sad, was her comment that natural and part of life, which basically confirms what I just said, it is perfectly normal to the natural man, but it is alien to those who know YHVH.

She started to get into New Age philosophy (even deeper) when she says that magic is part of the collective consciousness. New Age people believe that all forces are natural and are guided by unseen forces. They believe that many of the great men of history like Buddha, the Hindu deities, Mohammed, Moses, and Jesus are all ascended masters in this collective consciousness and that they came to Earth to teach us the truth. The problem is that each of these faiths thinks that they are the only true faith and that they possess the only truth, even though on the outside they will disavow that this is true, within their ranks they all believe to be the only true ones. New Age people believe that all people are connected to an “unseen ocean” and that magic and the Tarot can help us to manipulate our lives to keep in step with the forces of the “unseen ocean.”

Furthermore, the woman said that magic resides in the brain, in essence, it is hardwired there. We are just out of the right vibration to be able to see it. This is another New Age concept, not a Biblical one. One of the tenants of eastern meditation is that people have to empty their “monkey brain” of all earthly thoughts. When this is done the mind is empty and can become subject to magic and other occult ideas. The trouble is that an empty mind is a vacuum and vacuums like to be filled so if a person pulls themselves out of their brain and/or their heart then it’s an invitation for other forces to fill the void, so to speak. This further enforces that magic is not a natural thing, but a supernatural thing. She ends that particular diatribe by saying that Magic gives a person power to bring about unseen things. This sounds like people trying to be gods to me.

The woman went on to say that the Bible is a contradictory book because it makes Magic look evil in the Tanakh, but it is allowed in the Brit Hadasha, but she never gives any reference

scriptures from the Brit Hadasha. According to her, because the Bible is so hard to understand, and it contradicts itself it makes sense to use the Tarot because people can better identify with the images on the cards. Well, people can better identify with adultery, fornication, hate, murder, lust and a variety of other things but that doesn't mean that we should look toward those icons for answers. Scripture tells us to keep our eyes on Yeshua, the author, and finisher of our faith. It doesn't say that he makes us a house of cards out of the Tarot, but that he's around to give us answers via the real Ruach Ha Kodesh when our lives get complex. All we need to do is to trust that he will give us the answers, IN HIS TIMING, and that we not try to second guess what He is planning to do.

And last but not least, in an attempt to cement her theory that Magic, and divination are allowed by YHVH, she states that some of the great men of the Bible were diviners. She stated that Joseph was into divination because he interpreted dreams. She forgets to mention that there are periods of time between Joseph is asked to interpret dreams and when he actually interprets the dream. Those times were used to pray for interpretation, not to conjure up the meanings. Joseph was shown the dreams himself and was told the meaning so that he could give the interpretation to Pharaoh and yes, even his mother, father, and brothers. Again, what happened to Joseph and also to Daniel (which she mentions too) was the divine revelation of things that YHVH had shown to them and not some willy-nilly attempt to interpret symbols. Joseph and Daniel, scripture suggests, went in boldly to Kings, not hoping that what they were going to say might be right, but knowing what they were going to say was without a doubt true and certified by YHVH. She ended her diatribe by stating that ALL prophets used divination. She could not be more wrong.

Finally, she ends the video by hoping that the video resonates with the person watching it. Remember that I talked about the New Age basing a lot of their doctrine on vibration? They contend that people that are New Age seekers have a positive vibration while those who hold to YHVH's ideals have a negative vibration. Resonance is a characteristic of vibration. So, by making the wish that she made at the end, she was saying roughly, "I hope that this video helps you to finally understand the truth."

After I researched about Christian Destiny Cards I came upon a new fad that is being taken on by the same people that promote Destiny Cards, which in turn is endorsed by Bethel Redding. This new fad is called "Angels Speak Boards."

When I was young my sister and I dabbled with other neighborhood children in playing with Ouija Boards. While that was a long time ago I cannot attest that the pointer on the board ever spelled out anything for me nor can I speak for my sister in the matter. However, I have to say that in my research into occult activity in the lives of people who were put through what is called Alien Abduction, or any other sort of occult harassment, they ALL said that they played with Ouija Boards when they were children. Ouija is a gateway that basically allows you to give permission to evil entities (either deliberately or through ignorance) to influence your life in any way that they see fit to ruin you.

A cursory research into these boards showed me that Christians are beginning to dabble more and more into this form of sorcery. Like I said, if Bethel Redding, one of the queen mother churches of the NAR promotes a group that promotes the use of Angels Speak Boards then they are implicit with the use of these highly occult gateways. Angels Speak Boards are just Ouija Boards with a different packaging. If you know anything about the occult world you know that

fallen angels exist, so using these boards and trying to say that it is YHVH's angels communicating to you through the board is the ultimate act of ignorance and/or stupidity. When YHVH wants to send you a message he used the Ruach Ha Kodesh (Holy Spirit) to do so, but sometimes Christians are so wrapped up in deception or themselves that YHVH cannot communicate through the Ruach, so he sends an angel. Scripture tells us to be kind to strangers because sometimes we commune with angels, and they look just like you and me, not Teutonic looking characters with armor, shields, swords, and big white wings.

What Is Christ-Alignment?

We've seen the fallacy of the Tarot, Magic, and Angels Speak Boards and how these things are an abomination to YHVH. They were an Abomination in the Tanakh era, they were an abomination during the Brit Hadasha era and they are still an abomination.

Remember when I talked about false New Age Jesus' and false Holy Spirits? Well, there is a false Christ too. The Bible refers to him (or it) as The Antichrist. The New Age Christ is what I referred to earlier as a universal force, the collective ocean, as the woman on the video said. The New age believes people like Buddha, Mohammed, Moses, and others as those who possessed the Christ Consciousness and that they were enlightened masters. Coming into Christ Alignment is just another phrase that is used to say that people need to get to the right vibratory level so that they can be more like the Cosmic Jesus, you know, the one that the woman was crying out to for help during alien abduction events?

Years ago, I worked for the City of San Rafael in California. I worked in the electrical shop which was right next door to another mechanical shop. I talked to a guy that seemed

religious and we got on the subject of Jesus. He looked at me very seriously and told me that for a few months he was Jesus. He stated that he had the “Christ-consciousness” inside of him during that time and he truly was Jesus during that time.

We’re told of an encounter between Chava and the Nachash in the Garden. The Nachash tells Chava that if she eats the forbidden fruit her eyes will be opened, and she will become just like YHVH, knowing good from evil. From that very day until today and until YHVH remakes this world there are going to be people who want to become gods. A few years ago, the world was shocked as Shirley McClain stood on a beach and repeated a mantra, stating, “I am god” over and over again. People use things like divination and the Tarot because they want to have the power of knowledge, whether it be good or evil, but a power to control other people by pretending to know or have the power to be shown a person’s life or future life. The Bible prohibits those things. As much as the woman in the video/audio denied that the powers of the Tarot and Magic are demonic/fallen angelic, she is wrong, dead wrong. She, just like Chava want to be gods, but all they are is deceived, and if a supposed Church practices these things, well then, they are deceived and a perfect representation of the last days Church of Laodicea.

Multiculturalism and Christ Alignment

Probably two of the worst doctrines that that Church is taking in is Multiculturalism and Political Correctness, both which are bastard twin sisters that walk hand in hand. First off, multiculturalism is null and void in a body of true believers in Yeshua because scripture is clear that when we come to faith in Mashiach we become new creatures and it furthermore says that

old things are passed away and all things are made new. This means that the only culture in the Church of Mashiach is that of Mashiach and nothing else.

For centuries the Roman Catholic Church has played around with multiculturalism and it always leads to a watering down of Christian Faith and an acceptance of paganism. If you go to Latin America, you can witness where the Vatican has melded faith with pagan practices. You can observe the same if you go to any country or people where Catholicism has converted people to the Vatican faith. From the day that Constantine made the dubious claim that he had faith in Christ until this very minute the Roman Catholic Church has been the poster-child of what multicultural paganism turns Christianity into. It reminds me of a group of people who continue to breed solely within a community. The results are people that are not quite right in their thinking and their bodies become deformed because of mutations. If we could see what the Vatican looks like in the spiritual realm it would not be recognized as being anything human like, it would look like mutations with extra appendages, two heads, a cornucopia of mutations that would make a circus freak show look like normal humanity.

When we talk about the subject of Christ Alignment one naturally comes to the conclusion that there is an unalignment somewhere. If you see a chiropractor, he will offer to align your back. He does so because he can see that the vertebrae are not in aligned with each other. The term Christ Alignment however can have two meanings. It could either mean that it is an attempt to align Christ's People with Christ, or it could mean that it is an attempt to align Christ with other religions to create harmony or as it is often termed, making the church ecumenical, meaning that it is an effort to join everyone together while looking away from

differences. The problem with this theory is that there will always be one dominant game player that thinks he is right and the others are wrong, and attempt will always be made to mold the other partners into the image of the more dominant image.

My wife and I, along with a good friend were witness to the antics of a Church that was practicing Christ Alignment. One particular woman (much like Elizabeth Warren) said that she identified as being of Native American extract. She attended quite a few conferences where the Christianizing of paganism was the topic. So after a while she started to wear traditional Native American garb to church. She also brought a Native American drum with her. During worship she would play the drum and sometimes she would dance the Eagle Dance at worship.

I was a Jewish believer in the church and at the time I would wear my Kippah every day except when I slept. I had conducted research about the symbolism of many of the Native American customs and I was a bit concerned about the woman's worship style. In Native American culture the beating of the drum is supposed to symbolize the heartbeat of mother earth, the god that the New Age calls Gaia. The eagle is supposed to represent a messenger between the "Great Spirit" and the Shaman of the tribe. In addition, the feather of the eagle represents something very akin to Yin and Yang of the eastern cultures, one side of the feather being light symbolizing good and the other being dark symbolizing evil. She would also conduct classes that she called "Ancient Pathways," which is another Native American pagan custom, though she disguised it with Churchianity and as a prayer session. Scripture is quite clear that the only true path (there's only one) is YHVH Yeshua.

Of course, I felt led to discuss this with the pastor, just to let him know what I just explained above and to make him aware that there may be a little more to all of the culture thing than just someone that wanted to worship god in her own way. As usual, the whole thing got changed around and I was the bad guy because I wore my Kippah during the service and that made me just as pagan as this woman. We poured a lot of prayer time into that church and asked for wisdom to minister to the pastor in that and many regards but toward the end we were seen as troublemakers and we left the church to avoid any more conflict.

Since that day things in regard to the Church at large taking on paganism, the problem has only grown hundreds fold. Another church, in order to bring in more people mounted a campaign called, "Church Sucks." It did attract people to the church, but they didn't come to get saved, they came because they agreed with the pastor that Church Sucks. To the credit of the secular press in the area, they had a hard time with this new people attractor and were very critical of it. Then, in an effort to keep the new people the pastor started to incorporate secular songs by Katy Perry into the worship service. The church was severely compromised. I remember telling my wife that there must be something wrong with the pastor's life because he clearly was not hearing from YHVH. A year to the day that the "Church Sucks" theme was started it was discovered that the pastor had taken on a lover from within the congregation. As is usual, it split the church but not before the pastor was fired. He later divorced his wife and married his harlot.

I think that people in general are just too stupid to understand that you do not mess with YHVH's people and you do not change the tenants of the Christian Faith to accommodate the

pagans of this world. It is foolish to try to align Christ with anything because if one is in true faith they are in alignment with YHVH and the last time I looked Yeshua was perfectly aligned with himself and Aveinu. When a person or group try to change YHVH's Word from its original intent it only makes them look like idiots and it turns them into thieves, adulterers and false teachers, and we all know what happens to such people, especially false teachers, right?

Political Correctness like I said, is a twin sister of Multiculturalism. Political Correctness often castigates those who do not tend to the doctrine of multiculturalism. It also ties the hands of those who are commissioned to point out error within the Body of Mashiach. Often, when confronted with someone that is showing error the messenger is labeled as a hater, or as being judgmental upon which time the words of Yeshua are misconstrued. The messenger is cast as someone that is condemning when often the messenger is just someone that is bringing a unscriptural practice or a wrong lifestyle into question while comparing those things to what Scripture dictates.

Political correctness has had the same effect in the Church as it has in the secular world, it takes the offender and casts them in the light as a victim, wrongly transferring any guilt to the person that is trying to righteousness into the mix to correct wrongdoing. Churches that take on political correctness and multiculturalism aren't Biblical Churches. They have left their first love and in the name of worldly love they have become Laodicean in nature. NAR churches often practice political correctness while conducting multiculturalism while they try to castrate the messenger that YHVH has sent. They often excommunicate such messengers and have been known to ruin them socially and in some cases financially.

CHAPTER FOUR

HAS THE NAR HIJACKED THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION?

You know, I'm beginning to feel like a wet blanket lately. I see all of the happiness and revelries about Donald Trump being elected President of the United States and in many ways, I share in the happiness over this event. From a spiritual standpoint, I don't think that our nation deserves the respite that we've been granted by YHVH, but I'm not one to look a gift-horse in the mouth, so to speak. We suffered through eight years of Obama and I had hoped that all of that suffering would have caused people, not only to cry out to YHVH for deliverance but to drive people to their knees in humility and contriteness. I especially hoped it for those who call themselves by the Name of YHVH Yeshua, that they might become more circumspect. These things, for the most part, did not happen. Before the election results came in I thought that we would be suffering even worse under the heavy hand of someone like Hillary Clinton or Bernie Sanders. The election of Donald Trump surprised me.

I'm the type of person that looks for the deeper meaning of things and for what YHVH might be doing behind the stage. For instance, when everyone was reviling Obama, I saw him as a tool that YHVH was using to bring this nation to its knees. Having studied scripture before I know that YHVH has used many leaders throughout history to point His people to the narrow path that He requires us to walk upon so as to reach His Kingdom the way that He intends. He used the Egyptians to cause Israel to cry out to Him. YHVH used Nebuchadnezzar and Cyrus to accomplish his plan during the time of the Tanakh. Let's face it, YHVH has used ungodly men to bring about His Glory all throughout history. So, to use Obama was no new thing, but was that

tool really effective in bringing people to their knees, or was that tool responsible for showing just how stubborn and stiff necked the Church really is? I hate to say it, but the latter seems to be true.

So now we have Trump as our leader and I truly believe that Donald Trump is the genuine deal. One way to tell that is by looking at how many people hate him. The liberals hate him, which is no surprise, but so do some republicans. He has angered illegal aliens, Muslims, and even his own intelligence community. He has presented himself as some sort of quasi-Christian figure and has the backing of many evangelicals here in the States and abroad. He seems to champion righteous causes and he literally hates the ungodly government and social order that has risen to power for more than fifty years. He is a nationalist and is a champion against the socialist global agenda. He's pretty much the president that real Americans have hoped and dare I say prayed for, for decades.

This coming July I will have the honor of celebrating 39 years of walking with and serving YHVH Yeshua. He has given me a wonderful life in Him, and he's pulled off some incredible miracles in my life. I've also seen heartache both in my own life and the lives of those around me, and, in what has been done in some churches. I've had the displeasure as watching while people, whom I thought were honest people have compromised to get what they have wanted. I've been witness to pastor worship to the nth degree and I've seen an attack on the faith of people who have been trampled upon by those who aspire to climb the ladder leaps and bounds with no care to those who they have offended. I've watched as people with an avid hatred of someone make a complete about-face when they see that they can gain from that person if they are rising to power. Yes, I've seen these things in the world, but I've noticed them sadly

within the walls of what many call “The House of God.” Because I have witnessed such things I like to sit and watch when people rise to power, or should I say have power “ordained” upon them. I like to watch to see who their “new friends” are going to be, and I’ve gotten to the point where I can pretty well predict who those leeches will be and how they will manipulate the leader to get what they want.

When Trump was still campaigning, before the election occurred, he was hated and reviled by almost everyone that wasn’t a common person. Scores of Republicans reviled Trump and communed with the democrats that they have hated for years; both sides having found a common enemy. The phrase, “the enemy of my enemy is my friend,” played itself out many times while Trump was campaigning, but after he won the election, all of a sudden those within his own party who formally hated him decided to make peace with him. For some, I would assume that they figured that since Trump’s presidency was now a fact, they should probably get along with him so that they could work together. Others, I do believe feigned peace with Trump so as to be able to ride his shirt-tails for personal gain or gain and promotion for causes that they champion.

For this reason, I feel that Donald Trump should be careful. Although he is very intelligent and has business savvy that I cannot even imagine obtaining, I do believe that Trump has picked up some hitchhikers. They are out to befriend him at first, but will eventually overpower him, dispose of him and steal his car, so to speak. If Trump is not careful, these parasites, who come in the guise of Christians who pretend to care for him, will use him until they have obtained unimaginable power through deceit and prowess, then they will dispose of him, or have someone else do the dirty deed.

Notice that I said in the preceding paragraph that these people come in the guise of Christians. I know most believers in Yeshua are good and honest people who want nothing but the best for Trump, and everyone else for that matter. The thing is that we have to realize that we are told many times that there will come in the last day's people who call themselves believers, but they are wolves in sheep's clothing. Yeshua, when warning about the end times told of people who would deceive many, and I think that the scripture has two meanings, and both should be heeded.

For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. Matthew 24:5 KJV

For years I labored under the assumption that Yeshua's warning was given to tell us that there would be actual people who called themselves "Christ" and would deceive many. I don't discount that this is true because we've seen it over the past fifty years, and throughout all of history. There is, however, another way to look at that scripture that is just as valid, and it presents itself to be much more disturbing. Was Yeshua also alluding to the fact that there would be actual people who would affirm that He (Yeshua) is the Christ, yet they shall deceive many? The answer to that question is a resounding "YES." The examples of such are too numerous to mention in a complete list. Take for instance Joel Olsteen. No one would deny that Joel has said that Yeshua is the Christ, yet Joel preaches a false gospel and is deceiving many. The same goes for Benny Hinn, T.D. Jakes, Robert Tilton and scores of others. These men and many others are Charismatics by name.

In the beginning of the Charismatic movement the motives of pastors and church leaders were pure, but as the movement started to grow, things started to get not just weird, but flat out bizarre. This phenomenon is not limited to men either, seeing the likes of false teachers like Beth Moore, Joyce Meyer, During the last two decades of the last century we started to hear about false signs and wonders that happened at large gatherings of Charismatics, and the emphasis of those gatherings was not Yeshua Ha Mashiach is Lord, but the emphasis was on the supposed manifestations of the Ruach Ha Kodesh. Hearing reports about uncontrollable laughter were a bit strange, but when reports came out that people were mooing like cows, snorting like pigs and that they were writhing on the ground like snakes and/or shaking in what looked like epileptic seizures then those of us with discernment knew that these people were filled with something other than the Ruach Ha Kodesh. They were possessed instead by the Kundalini Hindu spirit.

In addition, these supposed special events, or mini-revivals if you will, have also been accompanied by strange manifestations such as what some call “gold dust” falling during services as well as precious gems being found on the floor of events. Add to that that the some have reported receiving gold fillings in their teeth and that there have been reports of “angel’s feathers” falling from the ceiling and upon congregants.

In addition, for an even more bizarre twist, orbs of light have appeared during some of these events and have been attributed to “angels” visiting the services. Subsequently, reports have been made that some event leaders have tried and have successfully summoned orbs to appear at the events. I do not argue against the notion that these orbs are angels, but I do enforce that they are not the angels that I would want at a service. I say that because orbs often are seen

during occult events and are many times seen during UFO sightings. That, along with the fact that YHVH's angels ALWAYS present themselves as men when they visit human males and females for the purpose of ministry. Oh, and given that fact, the common angel does not have wings, therefore, a wonder of angel's feathers falling during a service is nothing but a lying false sign and/or wonder.

What most people didn't realize is that these things went hand in hand with something titled the New Apostolic Reformation, or N.A.R for short. For the sake of anyone who hasn't read my past blog entries, or those who haven't heard listened to our "Opposing The Matrix" radio show regarding the NAR, I'd like to talk define what the abomination really believes. So, what is the NAR?

WHAT IS THE NAR? A MORE DETAILED LOOK AT HERESY

I aired a radio show last year that showed the interconnection between Mormonism and the NAR. We will look at how the NAR is defined and then some key terms that people within the movement use. I know that we reviewed some of this information in previous chapters, but it never hurts to recap information to keep a clear perspective.

NAR – New Apostolic Reformation.

The New Apostolic Reformation (NAR) is a title used to describe a movement that seeks to establish a fifth house within Christendom, distinct from Catholicism, Protestantism, Oriental Orthodoxy, and Eastern Orthodoxy, largely associated with the Pentecostal and

the Charismatic movements. Its fundamental difference from other movements is the belief that the lost offices of church governance, namely the offices of prophet and apostle, are being restored. Inspired by the G12 movement, it grows by discreetly recruiting pastors of independent congregations and nondenominational churches, by assimilating members from other churches through cell group meetings, and by frequent Church planting and rapid cytokinesis, including foreign missions around the globe. The churches spun out then form a loose network with a tightly knit history that serves as the basis of an otherwise informal and generally unadvertised far-ranging governmental structure. With this strategy, it expects to rapidly overwhelm and dominate the preexisting Christian denominations in the world.

Terms:

Like any movement, those who belong to the movement have key or buzz words that help them to identify each other. Of course, this does not only limit itself to movements, but to everyday life. For instance, in this day and age and at my work environment, which is very liberal, those of us that adhere to sane conservative doctrine often listen for buzz words that give us a hint that it is okay to talk about the news and such. The same is true with those who adhere to NAR theology. Some of those terms include:

***Apostolic governance** – The Apostle Paul’s assertion that Jesus appoints apostles within his church continues to this day. [Note: Apostles are no more special than the five other offices – see below]*

The office of the prophet – There is within the church a role and function for present-day prophets. [Note: Prophets are no more important than the five other offices – see below]

Dominionism – “When Jesus came, He brought the kingdom of God and He expects His kingdom-minded people to take whatever action is needed to push back the long-standing kingdom of Satan and bring the peace and prosperity of His kingdom here on earth.”

[There is nothing in scripture that comes close to aligning to this notion]

Theocracy – Not to be confused with theocratic government but rather the goal to have “kingdom-minded people” in all areas of society. There are seven areas identified specifically: religion, family, education, government, media, arts & entertainment, and business. [Also known as Seven Mountain Theology – more below]

Extra-biblical revelation – There is available to all believers the ability to hear from God. “The one major rule governing any new revelation from God is that it cannot contradict what has already been written in the Bible. It may supplement it, however.”

[The very word “supplement” means to complete or enhance when used as a noun. When used as a verb it means add an extra element or amount to. In either case this practice is unbiblical and warned against by YHVH Himself]

Supernatural signs and wonders – Signs and wonders such as healing, demonic deliverance, and confirmed prophecies accompany the move of God. [These are valid

things that accompany the Ruach Ha Kodesh. They can also accompany a false Kundalini spirit, which happens in NAR Churches]

***Relational structures** – church governance has no formal structure but rather is by relational and voluntary alignment to apostles. [This elevates the “apostle” to a supreme authority, allowing them to pontificate their will to all others in the church. It’s a Protestant form of Roman Catholicism]*

What Is the G12 Vision?

The G12 Vision is a Christian evangelism and discipleship strategy to fulfill the Great Commission. It is founded upon the idea that every Christian can mentor and lead twelve people in the Christian faith, following the example of Jesus. It was first modeled from a church in Bogotá, Colombia which has now grown up from an originally 8 members up to 200,000 members, composing of 45,000 cell groups.

What is the Five-Fold Ministry?

To any organization, there has to be structure and that or else one of two things will occur, either chaos or slavery. Rabbi Paul talked about such an organization in his letter to the Church at Ephesus:

And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the

edifying of the body of Christ. Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; Ephesians 4:11-14

We can see in the scripture above that there is a government within the Body of Mashiach. What the NAR asserts is that the list given in that scripture is a hierarchy that starts with Apostles and Prophets being the most important part of the Body of Mashiach and descending down after the prophet to those who do menial tasks and who are subject to the upper crust. There is nothing in that scripture that even comes close to making those separations. Rabbi Paul talks in another scripture about a similar list, what the Church calls gifts:

And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles? Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret? But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way. 1 Cor. 12:31

We see something interesting in that last scripture. We see that Apostle and Prophet are both gifts and that they are mentioned first. However, the teacher is third on the list, whereas it was dead last in the first scripture. Therefore, we know that teachers are just as important in YHVH's eyes as are apostles and prophets. There is, however, one key word in this latest

scripture that sums up what YHVH wants, and what the NAR ignores, that word is “best.” What is the Greek word for “best,” in this scripture and what exactly does it mean?

The Greek word for “best” in this scripture is *κρείττων* *kreittōn* and it means:

- more useful, more serviceable, more advantageous
- more excellent

It is quite obvious that the translator of this scripture might have picked the wrong definition because the first definitions work better than the second within the context of the passage and especially in the next chapter when Paul is showing us “a more excellent way.” It is quite evident that Paul was talking about each gift being used when it is needed and when it is more serviceable, more useful and more advantageous. For instance, if you, as a believer were parachuted into Borneo and you fell into a village of savages you would probably want the gifts of tongues, miracles, healings and prophecy first because it would establish you as someone with authority given from the natives would see as “the sky spirit.” After you have gained prominence among the tribe you would want the gift of teaching so as to be able to teach the Gospel of Yeshua to the tribe. After establishing a church within the tribe, you would then want to have the gift of an apostle so as to be able to visit other tribes with some of your new disciples in order to start the whole process over again. In the next chapter, Paul talks about the more excellent way being a life filled with faith, hope, and love, and he enforces that the greatest of those three attributes is love, because without those things, especially love, all of those other things are null and void.

I want to affirm that I do believe that the five-fold ministry is valid for the modern church and has been valid, but grossly ignored throughout most of the history of the Church at large. I affirm that I believe that it can only be used effectively when used in its correct manner, which is to edify the Body of Mashiach so as to glorify YHVH Yeshua. I assert that when it is abused like it is within the NAR, it is a heresy and an abomination.

“What is the Seven Mountain Mandate (7-M / 7M), and is it biblical?”

The Seven Mountain Mandate or the Seven Mountain Prophecy is an anti-biblical and damaging movement that has gained a following in some Charismatic and some Pentecostal churches. Those who follow the Seven Mountain Mandate believe that, in order for Christ to return to earth, the church must take control of the seven major spheres of influence in society for the glory of Christ. Once the world has been made subject to the kingdom of God, Jesus will return and rule the world. Here are the seven mountains, according to the Seven Mountain Mandate:

1. *Education*
2. *Religion*
3. *Family*
4. *Business*
5. *Government/Military*

6. *Arts/Entertainment*

7. *Media*

These seven sectors of society are thought to mold the way everyone thinks and behaves. So, to tackle societal change, these seven “mountains” must be transformed. The mountains are also referred to as “pillars,” “shapers,” “molders,” and “spheres.” Those who follow the Seven Mountain Mandate speak of “occupying” the mountains, “invading” the culture, and “transforming” society.

Does this sound familiar to you? Have you read or seen or heard of another religion that wants to conquer the same seven mountains? If you guessed that it is Islam, then you hit the nail right on the head. Islam has asserted itself into every one of the seven mountains in nations that it has taken over and is currently on its way to accomplishing these goals in Europe and in North America. The similarities between the NAR and Islam is so evident that even the Muslims can see it. The Muslim news outlet Al Jazeera has even published an article stating that it agrees that the NAR is America’s Taliban:

America’s own Taliban – A fast growing right-wing politico-religious presence plans to implement an end-times, Christian theocracy in the US.....

The ultimate goal is to replace secular democracy, both in America and around the world, with a Christian theocracy, an ideology known as “dominionism”. The supposed purpose is to “purify” the world for Christ’s return – again, strikingly similar to what the Taliban believe, but also significantly at odds with more common, long-standing

Christian beliefs about the “end times”, as well as the nature and purpose of prayer, and the roles of human and divine power.

Normally I would not quote from Al Jazeera, seeing that it is a propaganda machine for Islam. However, when your enemy compares what it thinks is a Christian element to what is clearly Koranic in nature it must be noted. The author of the article in Al Jazeera is not a Muslim, as far as I know; he is Jewish, which makes the contents of the article even more valid. When a Muslim outlet quotes a Jewish source about a Christian heresy, that is news.

I would be remiss if I did not address the Seven Mountain’s Mandate of eventually making the world a better place so as to present a perfect world to Yeshua when he returns to Earth at His Second Coming. I cannot think of any idea that is more unbiblical. Those of us that know Yeshua not only believe in him, we believe him; everything that he said in scripture, and we do not deviate from what He said. So, what did Yeshua say about the state of the world when he arrives? Let’s look at a couple of scriptures:

And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth? Luke 18:7-8 KJV

Yeshua’s question, as to whether there will be faith on Earth upon his return is rhetorical in nature. Yeshua knows that there will be no faith on Earth when he returns. Yeshua knows, as

exemplified by the following scripture that his return will be at a pinnacle where if he did not return all life on earth would be destroyed:

For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened. Matthew 24:21-22 KJV

A belief in handing over a perfect earth to Yeshua at the end of man's dominion over Earth presents some very big problems. First of all, it denies the words of Yeshua that I presented above. Second, it enforces the belief that Joel's Army, talked about in the book of Daniel consists of strong spiritual believers in Yeshua when it is clearly a demonic hoard. Third, it dismisses all notion that the events that occur in the latter days as illustrated both in Daniel and Revelation are the works of men and not YHVH. Finally, it dismisses the possibility of any sort of Harpazo (rapture) because if the Church is present to hand over a perfect world to Yeshua then there is no reason for YHVH to remove Yeshua's followers before YHVH's wrath against "those who worship the beast," begins. Despite

What is Replacement Theology / Supersessionism?

Replacement theology (also known as supersessionism) essentially teaches that the church has replaced Israel in YHVH's plan. Adherents of replacement theology believe the Jews are no longer YHVH's chosen people, and YHVH does not have specific future plans for the

nation of Israel. Among the different views of the relationship between the church and Israel are the church has replaced Israel (replacement theology), the church is an expansion of Israel (covenant theology), or the church is completely different and distinct from Israel (dispensationalism / premillennialism).

Coming from Jewish stock, nothing gets me more riled than replacement theology. Throughout history, every nation or group of people that has held to replacement theology has sooner or later either exiled Jews, persecuted Jews or killed Jews. It's quite evident from a cursory study of the Pauline letters and most of the Prophets of the Tanakh, that the Jewish people are not cut off, and it is clear that the Goyim have been accepted into Israel, not the other way around.

I have had some amusing conversations with people who believe in supersessionism. One such person, a former boss who claimed to have faith in Yeshua but showed absolutely no fruit once asked me about my faith. I answered that I am a Jew that believes in Yeshua. When I explained to him that all of the Disciples were Jewish and most of the Apostles, this man told me that he had always thought that the Disciples and Apostles had "converted." I laughed as I walked away and said, "converted from what?" He had no answer.

The Prophet books of the Tanakh and the Brit Hadasha are rife with scripture about Yeshua returning to retrieve scattered Israel back to the land. Well, you had to be there at one point to be called back, right? But my favorite discussion with those who think that YHVH has cast off the Jewish people goes like this:

Ignoramus: God has cast off the Jews because of their disobedience and the Church has become the new Israel

Me: Do you believe that Jesus is coming back?

Ignoramus: Yes, of course.

Me: Do you believe as the scriptures say that he is coming back to redeem Israel?

Ignoramus: Yes, that is what scripture says.

Me: Well then, if Jesus is coming back to redeem (buy back) Israel, and you claim to be part of Israel, then does that mean that you are not redeemed?

My last question usually causes people to walk away, or, they will try to turn the redemption into a spiritual event, not a physical event. Even if that was the case, it still means that the ignoramus is not redeemed, and if so, should not be part of the Body of Mashiach. Do you see the craziness that exists in this belief system?

It is interesting to note that aside from making Christianity more like Mormonism and Islam, will probably lead to the false religion known as Mystery Babylon, who is shown in Revelation to be a woman that sits on Seven Hills. Hmmm, there are those Seven Mountains again.

HOW DOES THIS RELATE TO A TAKEOVER OF THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION?

So, how does the NAR effect what is going on in our government today? We'll have a look at that, but before we do I want to make some things clear. First, I am happy that Obama is

not in office anymore, even though he was a tool that was used by YHVH to bring about correction. Second, I am happy that the Wiccan, Hillary Rodham Clinton lost the election. She would have literally hastened the death of our republic to the point where it would have happened within her first term. Third, I am happy that Donald trump is in office. I do think that he has good intentions to, as he says, “make American great again.” I also think that if he’s allowed to change the direction of the United States, he will. I like that he’s reversing the evil that has been done and promises to continue doing so. Whether he keeps fulfilling his promises remains to be seen, but I am optimistic.

I like the fact that Trump seems to be leading America in a biblical direction and that he seems to have a heart for Yeshua’s believers. Whether Trump has actually come to faith in Yeshua Ha Mashiach remains to be seen. What I am leery about is how so many high level “Christians” have jumped upon and appear to have seized the Trump Administration. What has really turned up my radar, and my prayers for discernment and wisdom is the fact that so many of those who have befriended Trump are men and women who appear to be adherents of NAR theology. We know from scripture that this world is really run by spiritual powers that are powerful and very deceiving. Donald Trump may be savvy when it comes to business, law and other worldly affairs, however, if he is not a believer in Yeshua, or is a new believer in Yeshua he can be easily manipulated in spiritual things. That is why it is more important than ever that we keep Trump in our prayers, namely that he hear the voice of YHVH and receive YHVH’s direction, not the direction of those who would manipulate him through evil devices.

It Is All in A Name

I am a firm believer that a person's name can influence the character of that person, or it can be an indicator of what that person will do. For instance, we are told in scripture that the angel told Miriam that the name of her baby would be Yeshua because he would save them from their sins. The name Yeshua means "salvation." We are also told that his name would be Emmanuel because that word means, "God with us."

Another good example can be seen when a name word study is done on the line of Noah. All Hebrew words have meanings and many times those words are defined by the verbs that are root words for the nouns. Taking the names of the patriarchs before the flood that were in Noah's line yields something known as "The Gospel in Genesis." I present it to you below:

I guess that if this doesn't convince someone that names have a meaning and that YHVH can use them for His glory than nothing will.

With all of these things in mind, perhaps it might be a good idea to look at the name meanings Donald John Trump, and also the known NAR players that are getting in cozy with Trump. So, what are the meanings of the names of Trump:

Donald: *The name Donald is a Scottish baby name. In Scottish the meaning of the name Donald is: Great chief, world mighty. From the Gaelic Domhnall. The name Donald has been borne by a number of early Scottish kings.*

John: *Hebrew Meaning: The name John is a Hebrew baby name. In Hebrew the meaning of the name John is: YHVH has been gracious; has shown favor. In Hebrew the name is actually pronounced Yohannan*

Trump: *There is a lot of confusion as to if Trump's surname has been Trump down through his family line. Some say that the name was Drumpf but was changed in the 1600's to Trump. Some say that his grandfather, Freidrich Trump changed it from*

Drumpf to Trump at the time of his immigration. There really is not a defining meaning for drumpf, but there is for Trump.

There are two differing meanings for Trump, one in German and one in English:

- *an English surname derived from Old French Trompeor “maker of trumpets” (modern surnames Trump and Trumper). Recorded in the 1270s in the forms Trumpur, Trumpe and Trump.*
- *a German surname, from a word for “drum.” Donald Trump’s ancestors changed the family surname from “Drumpf” to “Trump,” but the timing of that change isn’t clear.*

A Biblical meaning is to sound a herald by blowing a silver trumpet or shofar (ram’s horn).

Using the name definitions that we have found it is reasonable to assert that the name Donald John Trump means:

Great and mighty world chief upon whom YHVH has been gracious who will sound a trumpet.

Okay, so we see that Donald Trump’s name pretty well fits his personality. Even before he was President, he was a captain of real estate and finance. I see Trump taking on Ezekiel’s “watchman on the wall,” role, but at the same time I see him as not only sounding the alarm, but also mobilizing forces to fight against the enemy that is at the gates of the city, so to speak.

Having a name that means something is great, but unless a person lives up to their name then it is ineffective. However, again, I have to say that Donald John Trump is living up to what his names mean, and then some.

This name thing isn't foolproof:

Now just because a person has a name that has a meaning doesn't mean that they have to follow the trend of living up to the meaning of the name. In almost everything in this life, there are exceptions to a rule. Take for example King David's son Absalom. His name literally means "Father of Peace," yet he spent a lot of his time defying his father and raising an army against him. He might have been a father, but he was not peaceful. The Bible is quite clear that all men have some sort of destiny in the grand scheme of YHVH's plan for mankind; some are used more and some less, but all have a purpose. There are people who walk with YHVH faithfully, and there are people who are born to perdition, and there are people who are in a holding pattern waiting for their time to come to faith in Yeshua.

For instance, where the holding pattern is concerned. Today my wife and I went to eat at a Mexican restaurant over in a neighboring town. My wife was reading some of her Facebook posts while we were waiting for our food. Someone had posted something in Spanish and although I could make out some of the words, some I did not know. When the waiter came to the table my wife asked him if he would translate it for us. The man started to read the words to himself and then he looked a bit uncomfortable. The context of the texts was, "*we are all taught about the love of YHVH. The people who listen will live in heaven and those who did not listen*

will go to hell wishing that they had listened.” I felt bad for the guy because he was obviously bothered by the text and we both told him that we didn’t know what was in the text and thanked him for translating it for us. My wife echoed again how bad she felt about making him uncomfortable. I told her that it will be used for YHVH’s glory somehow. I said that perhaps his grandmother told him something like that and that it will speak to his heart and he will come to faith in Yeshua. We don’t realize that when we say something, or like when a parent names their children what sort of impact it will have. However, when a name is bestowed upon a child and that child lives up to the meaning of that name then we can be certain that they are set aside for a special purpose.

Can names be hijacked?

That having been said, I’d like to look at the names of some of the people that are in some way connected with what might be a rebellion against Donald Trump and who are associated with the New Apostolic Reformation.

Rafael Cruz – Father of Ted Cruz:

Cruz’s father is heavily into dominionism and the 7 Mountain Mandate. He claims to be an apostle and has made prophetic claims, thus according to NAR doctrine he is a heavy NAR player. But what about the name of Rafael Cruz, what does it mean?

The father of Ted Cruz is Rafael Bienvenido Cruz y Díaz – Etymology

- **Rafael** – God Has Healed

- **Bienviendo** – You are welcomed
- **Cruz** – Cross
- **Y** – And
- **Diaz** – Son of Diego (James – Jacob)

The way that the Spanish-speaking world names their children is quite different than those in the English-speaking world are accustomed. In the English-speaking world, when a woman marries they traditionally shed their maiden name and take on the surname of their spouse. In the Spanish world, however, things are much different. For instance, my deceased wife's maiden name was Maria de Lourdes Peredo Camarena. Maria is Latin for Mary, de Lourdes means, "of Lourdes" to venerate the Marian apparition in Lourdes France. Her third name was her father's surname and her very last name was her mother's maiden name. If we go back one generation, Peredo was her maternal grandmother's maiden name. It can get quite confusing for those who have not been around Spanish culture.

This man has quite a beautiful name because when you translate it out, leaving out the "y," it renders, *"God has healed, and you are welcomed (via) the Cross Son(s) of Jacob.* His name is actually a mini version of the Gospel of Yeshua. But what about his son, Ted Cruz?

Is There a Meaning to Ted Cruz's Name?

I for one was surprised to find out that the name "Ted" is just a nickname that was given to the son of Rafael Cruz. I labored under the assumption for the longest time that his actual

name was Theodore (Theodoro). I came to this conclusion that his name was Theodore simply because my maternal grandfather's brother had the name Theodore and they called him Ted. When I researched his name (Cruz's), it came back to me that Ted is also a nickname for people named Edward, hence Ted Kennedy was Edward Kennedy. So, I found out that Ted Cruz's full name really is:

Rafael Edward "Ted" Cruz

Rafael – We already know that Rafael means "Elohim Has Healed" and we know that it fits well into his father's name. That having been said, let us proceed with defining his middle name:

Edward – Means "rich guard", derived from the Old English elements ead "wealth, fortune" and weard "guard". This was the name of several Anglo-Saxon kings, the last being Saint **Edward** the Confessor shortly before the Norman conquest in the 11th century.

Cruz – We know from above that Cruz is Spanish for "Cross."

- Rafael – God has healed
- Edward – Rich Guard
- "Ted" – God's Gift (see below)
- Cruz – Cross

The nickname "Ted" has some interesting meaning:

*Short for Theodore: **Origin of the name Theodore:** Derived from the Latin Theodorus, which is from the Greek Theodōros, a compounding of the elements theos (god) and dōron (a gift): hence, “God’s gift.” Var: Theodor. Short: Theo*

His legal name spells out, God had healed, rich guard, cross. Could it mean spelled out that *God has healed (via) the rich guard of the cross?* Could this be used to appeal to believers in Mashiach? If we could incorporate his middle name into the mix it could be rendered, *“God has healed (he is) the rich guard of God’s Gift, of the Cross.”* Both Father and son have beautiful names and point to YHVH’s gift to mankind, forgiveness via Yeshua’s sacrifice on the tree. The thing that we need to see is if these names are being used in these two individuals for good, or could they be turned around to be used for evil. There is one more major player in this whole fray, that being Mike Pence.

Michael Richard Pence:

You have to admit that Mike Pence was not a common household name before we heard that Trump was considering him for a vice president choice.

Michael – From the Hebrew name מִיכָאֵל (Mikha’el) meaning “who is like God?”. This is a rhetorical question, implying no person is like God. Michael is one of the seven archangels in Hebrew tradition and the only one identified as an archangel in the Bible.

Richard – The Germanic and Celtic first or given name Richard derives from German, French, and English “ric” (ruler, leader, king) and “hard” (strong, brave), and it, therefore, means “powerful leader”. Nicknames include “Dick”, “Dickie”, “Rich”, “Richie”, “Rick”, “Ricky”, “Rickey”, and others.

Pence – The surname **Pence** is a toponymic surname which described where the original bearer held land. In this case, the surname was originally derived from the Old English words penn, meaning an area that housed stray animals and penn which referred to a hill.

Penz or Benz – Although the name Benz sounds like a German name because of the famous luxury car manufacturer with the same name, it is believed that the name is an English derivative of the name Benedict. The English name Benedict is a derivative of the Latin ‘Benedictus’ which means ‘blessed’. While some might consider this name to figure into the man’s name meaning I see it as being too much of a stretch on the name to have any validity, although if he does know Yeshua as his Lord and Savior then he is indeed blessed.

Who is like God? Strong and Brave, upon a hill.

Or,

Who is like God, strong and brave, who pens up the wild animals.

It should also be noted that Pence is kind of confused when it comes to his “Christian” identity. He grew up Catholic and claims that at one point he had a Born-Again experience. In an interview, he dubbed himself “a born-again evangelical Catholic.” It is reported that he doesn’t

attend mass anymore but that he and his family were attending an evangelical church but at this time it appears that he and his family are looking for another church. Since he hasn't denounced his affiliation with the Vatican then we have to assume that he still holds to Roman Catholic doctrine, thus he could be the liaison that ties the Vatican into what appears to be evolution of many people into what will become some sort of NAR, Mormon and Vatican trinity of world conquering hybrid Antichrist soldiers.

So, with daddy Cruz and his son we have two individuals whose names glorify the work of Yeshua on the cross and proclaim it as a blessing for mankind that all are welcomed to receive. Both of these men are not key figures in the White House at this time. Pence, however, is in the White House as Trump's second in command. During the campaign we constantly heard how Trump and Pence were going to "drain the swamp," a term that was and is being used to mean that they are going to clean up Washington D.C. and government around the country. Since they have gotten into office they have been doing that from day one, exposing corrupt individuals and a corrupt and highly partisan press corps.

So, We Know Some Players, Now Is There A NAR Plan in Place?

I guess the answer to that is that we will not know fully until we can look back and see things with a clear perspective. We can, however, look at the players I've mentioned and see how things fit into the NAR's Seven Mountain theology. We also must first look at some things that transpired during the bid for the White House and how Mormonism plays into this story.

Right at the start, I think that it's important that everyone understand that Mormonism has always been intent on someday running the United States. Their plans are very much akin to the Seven Mountains Mandate of the NAR. Let's look at that mandate again:

Here are the seven mountains, according to the Seven Mountain Mandate:

1) Education

2) Religion

3) Family

4) Business

5) Government/Military

6) Arts/Entertainment

7) Media

When you look at the similarities of Mormon Mandates and NAR's Seven Mountain Mandate, and you look at both look at church structure (Apostles and Prophets) it is spooky, to say the least and one has to wonder if either they are in cahoots with one another now or will be at a later date. I mean, after all, the NAR is calling it a fifth column, separate and distinct from all other movements of Christianity, but so does Mormonism, right? As a matter of fact, Rick Joyner, a so-called prophet with the NAR was even heard to say about the Mormon White Horse Prophecy, "*.....who knows, maybe this was a true prophecy.*" He says it at the end of his video found on YouTube.

Like Joyner says in the video, the White Horse Prophecy basically says that when the Constitution of the United States is in peril and hanging by a thread, a Mormon President will

rise up and save the Republic. If you know Mormonism at all, you know that it is an extraterrestrial cult wrapped with Christian Holiday Paper. To endorse a prophecy made by the founder of a pseudo-Christian cult is abominable. Well, since the NAR is an abomination I guess that we can't expect their heads or followers to practice righteousness. Oh, and by the way, Joyner is a self-proclaimed and proud member of the Knights of Malta. Go to his webpage to read his concocted explanation of his joining this order. Oh, and when you read, remember that he endorses Mormon prophecies, so he's not too tightly wrapped when it comes to the truth.

Glenn Beck is a Mormon newscaster sensationalist that has a large audience of Mormons and many other peoples. There are many that do not know that he is a strong Mormon so they listen to him intently. In many ways, Beck is akin to the basic Mormon missionary that comes up to your front door riding a bike. They, like Beck, try to convince their "mission" by using mostly scripture and current social ills to convince their audience that what they are saying is gospel truth, leaving the truth until later in their spiel.

Glenn Beck was a loud proponent of Ted Cruz, in fact, that in a speech that he made during the campaign of a Mormon running for office, Beck talked about the White Horse Prophecy and then endorsed Ted Cruz for president. At one point, Cruz stood up and clapped during the speech. Now I ask you, what is a good Baptist boy doing at a rally for a Mormon politician and why didn't he ever refute that he was being hailed as the one that could fulfill the White Horse Prophecy. At other times Beck suggested that Cruz would be the one to fulfill the prophecy.

Mitt Romney is another Mormon that endorsed Cruz. Now there will be some who will say that he didn't come out and say that he didn't endorse Cruz, but he did say that he was voting for Cruz because he didn't like what he called, "Trumpism." It is interesting that since the election and the rise of Trump to the presidency, Romney has softened his formally rabid view of Trump, and the same is true for Ted Cruz.

Earlier we talked a little about Rafael Cruz, Ted Cruz's father. Rafael Cruz adheres to Dominionist doctrine. We looked at how dominionist believe in the Seven Mountain doctrine where 7 sectors of society will be taken over by Christians for the Kingdom of God so that when Yeshua returns he will be presented with a perfect world to rule over. Rafael declared in 2013 that his son was anointed to be a king that would take over those seven spheres of society for God's Kingdom. The preacher at the event said that Kings never went out to war unless they received blessings from the priests. I could be wrong, but I do not ever remember reading that in scripture. I do remember that Kings often consulted prophets before going out to war or before starting major endeavors, but never priests. Conveniently, Rafael Cruz also claims to have the prophetic gift.

We know from history that Ted Cruz did get elected as a Senator from Texas, but he also ran for President of The United States and failed to win during the Primaries. So, in effect, Ted Cruz's anointing did not pan out, at least right now, but who knows what the future holds. Getting back to Glenn Beck, after Trump became president and all efforts to challenge the election results had either failed or proved that Trump actually received more of the popular vote

than had been previously reported, Glenn Beck changed his mind and he decided that he would back Trump's presidency.

Parasites and Their Hosts

When we think of parasites we tend to get an uneasy feeling. I think that we feel that way because in civilized society we tend to get our nutrition from things that were once alive but have died because they were bred for the purpose of one day being our nutrition. Many believers in Yeshua today will literally condemn someone that decides to eat Kosher because eating Kosher is found in the Torah and according to their flawed theology the whole Torah was nailed to the Cross with Yeshua and therefore is not important anymore; we discussed that earlier. Regardless of what they think, those of us who know that YHVH has our best interest in mind know that one of the many reasons why we should not eat some animals is that those animals carry parasite eggs and/or larvae which can infest within us if we eat them, especially if that meat is not cooked thoroughly.

Parasites are insidious because they feed on their hosts without killing them, at least right away. As long as the host thrives so does the parasite. Parasites are also insidious because they not only pass on their eggs (or spores) through fecal matter, but they create places in the body where they lie mostly dormant until the host is eaten. Probably one of the most vicious parasites is the tapeworm. This worm inhabits the intestine of its host, hooking onto the intestine wall using something called a scolex. The scolex has barbs that hook onto the intestine wall. The tapeworm takes nutrients from the food that the host ingests, using those nutrients to grow in size and to produce more eggs. Most of the eggs are released in the feces of the host, but some are

able to enter the bloodstream of the host where they find themselves to muscles and sometimes the brain where they form cysts. The cysts can remain dormant for years but present problems later.

I know that each and every one of you has had at least one person in your life that acted in such a manner as a parasite. We've all had supposed friends, or maybe even a relative that constantly drains us of energy and/or resources. They cannot make it on their own and they need someone to feed off of. Sometimes they are people who come into our lives to suck us dry of our spiritual life. They keep us so busy tending to their lack of faith that they wear us out spiritually and we tend to question our faith.

We also know that there are parasites in society. By that I'm denoting that there are those who are able to work, yet they refuse to because it is easier to take nutrients from the productive people in society. It is important to know that there are parasites, like the tapeworm that is by nature a parasite, but there are also parasites that that are purposeful predators that are set out to rise to power using parasitic ways. The NAR is the second type of parasite.

Trump, A Perfect Host and The NAR the Perfect Parasite

Before I begin with this section I want to state that I believe in and I believe Yeshua Ha Mashiach. And, like probably 99 percent of you who are reading this, I look forward to the day when Yeshua returns to establish his Kingdom here on Earth. My heart's desire is that all the world would come to know Yeshua as their Lord and Savior and I will preach His Gospel to

everyone who will listen. I do however realize that that world is what it is, a planet in rebellion toward YHVH, thus I realize and affirm that Yeshua and only Yeshua can take this world back into submission to Him, and I know that it will only happen after mankind almost destroys itself and the world. I know this because Yeshua told us this in scripture, several times over at that.

Some might say that I am being mean by what I am about to say, or have said thus far in this chapter, but we're told by Yeshua to know people by the fruit that they produce. A good farmer can tell in advance whether his yield for the year will be a good yield or whether his crop will bear little or no yield. A good vine dresser can tell near the beginning of the growing season if there will be many grapes or little good fruit. He or she researches what the weather is predicted to be, will it be a wet season or dry; will it be warmer or cooler than normal. They look at the soil to see if it needs fertilizer and they scan constantly for signs of insects or blight.

Finally, they talk to other vine-dressers to confirm that their assessment matches those of their peers. I am not the only believer that sees the danger of the NAR and I am not the only one that is showing it as an apostasy and abomination. There are many of us, and YHVH has given to us all the same spirit of discernment and YHVH has shown us the same dangerous ways of this incredibly evil movement that calls itself by the name of Mashiach, but that is as blatantly counterfeit as is a wolf in a sheep's fold.

Again, I do believe that Donald Trump has a legitimate calling from YHVH to lead this nation at this time, but I do believe that one mistake that he has made is that he has unknowingly taken in the parasitic NAR into his administration, and they will continue to feed off of the

Trump administration until they do not need him anymore. As I mentioned in a previous article, the NAR, whether they know it or not, is a bed partner with the Mormon Church and the Vatican.

There is an interesting scripture in Revelation that I think connects the NAR and its fellow harlots as a tool of Satan.

So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication: And upon her forehead was a name written, Mystery, Babylon The Great, The Mother Of Harlots And Abominations Of The Earth. And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration. And the angel said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel? I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carrieth her, which hath the seven heads and ten horns. The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is. And here is the mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth. Revelation 17:3-9

Note that the beast is an entity that comes out of the bottomless pit. This is clearly Satan. Not also that there are three women mentioned after chapter three of Revelation. One woman is the woman mentioned in this scripture. Another woman is mentioned and represents Israel. A third woman is the Bride of Mashiach. Our focus is on the first woman that I mentioned. Note that the scripture says that the woman is adorned in jewels, gold, and pearls. If you watched the video about Rafael Cruz, you saw that one of the main goals of the NAR is to acquire all the riches of the world. Notice that the scripture says that the woman was dressed in raiment that was purple and scarlet. Purple is the color of royalty and scarlet is the color of blood. The NAR believes that they are a royal priesthood. Could it be that the NAR will be scarlet because of the blood of Christian martyrs that it killed because we would not subject ourselves to counterfeit Christian doctrine?

I mentioned earlier that Al Jazeera published an article that called the NAR, America's Taliban, because of the militant ways that they condone to take over the seven mountains of society. Many times, militancy leads people to do unethical and/or illegal things which cause them to tweak their own beliefs to justify what they do. In Islam, there are four modes of operation that allow Muslims to lie so as to further the cause of Islam. The four forms of deception are:

Muslims are allowed to lie to unbelievers in order to defeat them. There are two forms:

Taqiyya – *Saying something that isn't true as it relates to the Muslim identity.*

Kitman – *Lying by omission. An example would be when Muslim apologists quote only a fragment of verse 5:32 (that if anyone kills "it shall be as if he had killed all mankind")*

while neglecting to mention that the rest of the verse (and the next) mandate murder in undefined cases of “corruption” and “mischief.”

Tawriya – *Intentionally creating a false impression.*

Muruna – *‘Blending in’ by setting aside some practices of Islam or Sharia in order to advance others.*

When you look at the NAR you can identify that some of these practices have already been used to advance their cause. For instance, Taqiyya has been practiced just by the fact that NAR adherents claim that their doctrine is biblical, which it is not. A good example Kitman can be seen by the NAR twisting the scripture that we looked at earlier, where different offices are given to the church members. The NAR says that Apostles and Prophets are more important than every other office, but we saw how that is not true. In essence, they took a scripture out of context to serve their own agenda. They have committed Tawriya by saying that they are a new Fifth Column of Christianity that replaces all of the others, giving the false impression that all other Christians are not real believers but can be if they join with the NAR. Lastly, they have committed Muruna by denying and criticizing the established fact that Yeshua is returning to save a dying world, a doctrine that Yeshua Himself established, and replacing it with a false doctrine that states that THEY will make the world better and then out of the goodness of their hearts they will present it to a returning Yeshua. If they are acting in such a manner at the beginning times of their movement it can only get worse. A house is only as good as the foundation upon which it is built. To quote the words of Yeshua:

For if they do these things in a green tree, what shall be done in the dry? Luke 23:31

Yet another thing to note is that Islam promotes itself as a religion of peace. There is a little bit of truth about that statement, but there is a time factor that they fail to tell us about. Yes, the Muslim believes that theirs is a religion of peace, but what they fail to say is that the only way that peace will come is when all the world subscribes to the Islamic Faith. Those in the NAR are quiet clear that they are on a mission to win the world for their Christ and one can't help but speculate that their goal will not come from real conviction of a person to come to believe in Christ, but like Islam is doing now, the conversions will be forced. It will be a replay of all of the Inquisitions, Pogroms and Holocaust's all rolled into one. The NAR is setting itself up to be an integral part of the Best System of Revelation, and it would not surprise me to find out that it is not out of ignorance that they are doing so, but that it is being purposefully done here and now.

So, What Do I Think Might Happen in The Next Four or Eight Years?

First of all, I want to establish that although I feel that YHVH is showing me things, I do not want to present this information as so many of the NAR prophets do, with assuredness that they are hearing from YHVH when it is quite clear that they are not. Yes, YHVH has given me a prophetic calling, but having studied the prophets I know that YHVH often disseminates information so that people cannot get the date, ruminate on it and then make decisions that could alter an outcome. We know that YHVH sees the end from the beginning and the beginning from the end, but we never do, and when we think that we can understand YHVH, he tends to throw us a curve ball and we go back to square one. Furthermore, let me reiterate that I would love

nothing better than for our nation to fall on its knees, to repent and to call out to YHVH so that He can heal our land. Always remember, YHVH promised to heal our land and he never said that he would use the NAR to do it. In addition, YHVH always starts revivals by dealing with the hearts of people who are already saved, or claim to be saved before he uses them as lights to lead the lost out of darkness.

Now I could be wrong, but I do not see Donald Trump as being part of the NAR per se. As I illustrated above, I see Trump as being a host and the NAR as being the parasite that lives off of the host. Unfortunately, if parasites aren't dealt with they will almost always overcome the host, depriving the host of nutrients until the host's immune system is so weak that the host succumbs to malnutrition or to other opportunistic diseases. With this in mind, I feel that the NAR will ride on Trump's coattails until he is no longer needed. If Trump can be misled and NAR operatives can be placed in all of the Seven Mountains, then he will probably be eliminated. That doesn't mean that they would kill him, although it is possible because to the NAR the end justifies the means. Hopefully it would be an impeachment and not involve the taking of blood.

When Trump is removed the mantle would fall to Pence whom I believe is deceptively hiding his NAR doctrine from everyone in order to appease Trump and to give the impression to the citizens that he's just a weak and ineffective everyday Christian. When Trump is out of the way he will become a roaring lion. He will probably appoint Cruz as his vice president. Remember that the Vice President is also the President of The Senate, so appointing Cruz as VP will cement Senate obedience to Pence. There is a possibility that Trump could appoint two more judges to the Supreme Court during his term(s) and if Pence or any other person close to Trump

is NAR they could talk Trump into appointing two NAR judges to the Supreme Court, causing the court to tilt toward obedience to the NAR.

We have to remember the name meanings that we explored above. Remember that Trump's surname means to herald with a trumpet. Trump is doing just what his name means, he's heralding in a Revived American Order, so to speak. We also saw that both Cruz's' names denote a fidelity to the Cross of Yeshua. Is it possible that someday Ted Cruz will address the public to tell us that his very name means that he is here to usher in a New Christian Order to bring peace to our land? Could it be that some sort of national crisis will cause the public to call upon Cruz to defend the Constitution, which is hanging by a thread. Remember, two prominent Mormons endorsed Cruz. Just imagine if you will, the nation in shambles and a Hispanic president steps up and calls upon all Christians, Catholics and Mormons to help to restore the Republic. If such a thing happened it would cement the NAR into power for many years to come.

What could bring about such a crisis within America? The answer is simple. Remember that the NAR has the same aspirations as Islam, to be the dominant religion on Earth. They simply cannot exist together, and one has to be eliminated. Even today it is pretty well established that there are Islamic terrorist sleepers all over our nation. Some report that there are Jihad training camps in the isolated places of our nation where the warriors for Jihad are training to kill Americans. A war with Islam will be both an internal and external war, and the US will probably go it alone. It could be a war of America against the world, seeing that Muslim militants are infiltrating just about every free nation and government on Earth. A Christian crusader who was prophesied by both the NAR prophets and a Mormon founder would fit the

bill perfectly. Remember, Glenn Beck was given a prophetic mantle by the NAR and Beck said that he thinks that Cruz will fulfill the White Horse Prophecy. Do you see it all adding up?

The next chapter will address what the country will be like after the NAR wreaks havoc here in the States. After they vanquish Islam they will become authoritarians over the population of the United States. The citizens will push back and after they gain control from the NAR they will get a new leader who will hate all things called “religious.”

Summary:

In summation, I hope that I am wrong. It would be nice, and I would be completely satisfied with a full term(s) Trump administration that would be able to Make America Great Again. I frankly do not see the events of Revelation playing out until the middle of the 21st Century. HOW THE N.A.R. DOCTRINE WILL AFFECT BELIEVERS IN YESHUA

Don't get me wrong, I am quite concerned about current affairs when they are detrimental to the health of my loved ones, but I rejoice when they look to be heading toward a time that will bring about prosperity and health for my family. My family includes my immediate family, but also brothers and sisters in Yeshua.

When Trump was elected I was elated and awestruck, and still am both to some degree, although I think that perhaps he's doing too much too soon, but history will show if I'm right about that. I find myself hoping that I'm wrong. I think that I can best relate it to drug addiction. I am a member of the Baby Boomer Generation. I came in sort of at the end of that group, and I got to see the mistakes that were made by the early baby-boomers. The early boomers were the ones that were marching on the streets of American cities in the 60's. They were the ones that became radical communists who thought that blowing up police and spurring other forms of violence was the answer for bringing social change. They were also the ones that brought about the hippie movement of peace, love, free sex and rampant use of drugs to escape from what they thought was a bad society. Don't get me wrong, young boomers that were moral and caring far outnumbered the dregs of Boomer society, but the powers behind the scene are focused on the miscreants and while they demonized all good and honest people.

As fate has it, the dregs of our generation often rose to the top, many times because their parents were famous, or they were in a position to pull strings and pay off the right people. Jane Fonda is a good example of this privileged societal dreg. Daddy, Henry Fonda, was a famous conservative actor and Jane rode on his coattails of fame in order to become one of the useful idiots that the communist liberal left used to promote lawlessness. The heat from this stunt caused a Zuni missile on the plane behind him to misfire which in turn caused a plane down the deck to explode and start a chain reaction. Even if this story isn't true, McCain, instead

of running to aid those trying to fight the fire, ran downstairs in the ship and watched on a monitor. He also hopped on a chopper leaving the ship and flew to Saigon for what he termed, “a little needed R&R.” Later, McCain would enter politics and would become a long-term Senator from Arizona. Yet another case where someone had people behind the scenes coddling someone born with a silver spoon. McCain claims to be a Republican politically, but his actions show him to be in the pocket of George Soros and like I said earlier, one has to wonder if McCain was groomed for his current resistance to all things American and his affinity for all things communist and one world order.

When I was a young man, my dad always would tell me that the future held a scenario where the Soviet Union would become more like America, and America would become more like the Soviet Union. He said that it would have to be this way in order for the New World Order to take over. He also told me that the two political parties, that always seemed to be diametrically opposed to each other, were in reality just two groups that were heading toward the same goal by traveling what appeared to be different roads. The song denotes that both will follow different roads with the goal being ending up on Scotland. Thus, you have the American political system, consisting of political fascists taking one road and corporate fascist taking another road, but both coming together in the New World Order.

McCain and Fonda are the poster children for the neo-fascist hippies that everyone once thought to be harmless but have risen to be supposed voices for all “good citizens” everywhere. The problem is that while there were some of my generation that listened to the messages of people like my two examples above, they procreated vociferously a new generation (Gen-X) that is at the very least two-thirds in number when it comes to the politics of Fonda and McCain.

The Gen-X Generation, for the most part, consists of hard working individuals, but the slackers in the Gen-X generation are far much worse slackers than the Baby Boomer Generation produced. The Gen-X slackers are people of entitlement, expecting rights that they did not earn. They are people who listen to the degenerates of the Baby Boomer Generation and adopted socialistic and communistic ways that they are taught without batting an eye or having a thought that what they are being taught is wrong.

Whereas most of Baby Boomers have had some exposure to Church or Synagogue education, Gen-Xers are more apt to reject religion and many of them that have had some sort of religious upbringing have rejected it outright when they become adults. For instance, it is not uncommon for Christian Gen-Xers to have statues of Buddha in their garden or to have dream catchers hanging from their rear-view mirror. When

questioned about such things the common answer is akin to, “well I like it and I don’t put any spiritual connection to it.” Many seem to be totally ignorant (some willfully) when it comes to bringing icons from false religions into their lives and/or their households.

As the Gen-X Generation came of age they started to procreate. Their generation started to produce children born into what is known as The Millennial Generation. As history progresses it seems that each generation tends to be more watered down than the previous one. It is very hard to find people in the Millennial generation that give a darn about anything other than themselves. The problem has gotten so bad that many employers are having difficulty keeping employees because the self-entitled Millennials are demanding work schedules that accommodate them rather than the employee accommodating their employer. They seem to be an upside-down generation. A few years ago, I wrote a book about the fact that Darwinism is dying and Evolution is itself Evolving. A chapter in the book was about a group of children that the New Age calls “Indigo Children.” Indigo Children are what every other generation has called spoiled brats. The New Age ascribes every bad trait of a spoiled child and chooses to edify those traits as the child being part of an evolutionary advancement in the human species. The similarities between the New Age’s Indigo Children and what we know to be the Millennial Generation are so close that is alarming. Let me encourage you, if you want, to look for articles on how employers are having to deal with Millennials. Their approach, which I do not agree with, is to change the workplace so as to accommodate the little snowflakes.

Before we move on, let’s run through a little scenario and walk through the generations of one family to see how things have gotten into such a mess. Sometimes I envy my father’s generation. Yes, they were a little rebellious, but mostly got that rebellion out of their system in

their teen years after which they became valuable citizens of society. I'll ascribe a name to a member of that generation, say that the person representing that generation is named John. John's wife gives birth to a son named Brad. Brad is taught to respect his elders, to respect authority and is groomed to be like his father, a respectful member of society. Brad is sent off to a liberal college to acquire a degree so that he can take over his dad's business. While in school Brad is taught by some professors who are ardent communists. Through constant badgering and belittlement, and with their propagandistic lesson plans Brad starts to change and he becomes like his peers and his professors. Brad sometimes goes home for the holidays and his family sees the change in Brad. The change causes the family to address Brad's behavior. His professors said that this would happen because his parents are capitalists and they are the enemy. Brad is convinced by his professors that he should change his major to the Law so that he can become a lawyer who can fight all of the injustices that current society places on people that are oppressed by the capitalists. Brad shacks up with his girlfriend and they have four children out of wedlock, two boys, and two girls. Brad is a Baby boomer and his four kids belong to Generation-X. Most nights when he comes home Brad discusses his cases with his common-law wife and children at the dinner table. Brad whips them up into a frenzy of anger as he talks about racial inequities, corporate greed, how women are treated unfairly in the workplace and yes, how homosexuals are just people like them, that are grossly oppressed.

Brad's boys both go to college to follow in their father's footsteps; they want to right the wrongs in society. They both land jobs with the ACLU, one in New York and the other in San Francisco. Brad's kids go separate ways where sexuality is concerned. His oldest son Marcus married a backslidden Christian girl who gave him three beautiful children, however, she has reconnected with her religion and this has caused Marcus to consider divorce. Besides, he's

having an affair with two interns at work and they are much more compliant than the religious girl at home.

Brad's younger son, Rick becomes friends with his homosexual roommate and soon they are lovers. Rick is elevated to the Gay Rights unit of the ACLU. Brad's oldest daughter, having heard all of the propaganda about women not having equal rights, becomes an ardent feminist. She becomes so militant that she hates older brother and her father. Strangely, she is very close to her younger brother. Sally, Brad's youngest child falls in with a group of evangelical Christians at school. She reads the Bible, listens to her Christian peers and after a brief struggle with her identity she becomes a born-again believer in Yeshua. She meets a nice boy in college with strong Christian ethics, the son of a pastor. They fall in love, have a real wedding and after a few years, they have five children, all of which cannot understand why their grandfather, his wife and their uncles and aunt don't invite them to family events. Sally and her husband have seen what college does to young minds, so they encourage their children to go to a technical school or to a conservative Christian college, while planning to keep a close watch on their kids' education and their souls.

Do you see the degeneration that has occurred in just four generations? John had good intentions, but he unwittingly turned his kids over to wicked and vile professors that corrupted them. He and his wife lived long lives. They found joy in Sally and her family but mourned over the utter loss of their other children and their offspring. Although this was a fictitious story it is based on what I have seen so many times. Now multiply this scenario perhaps hundreds of thousands of times. When you do so you can see why so many people fail to listen to the truth and why so many are acting violently in the streets.

When my generation was young it was unheard of for anyone to make public threats against the President of the United States, and if anyone did, they were usually admonished by the Secret Service and sometimes locked up for an extended period. We live in a day when a vast number of people feel that they are entitled to programs where they receive things for free and many generations have lived this way for so long that these things are expected. We live in a society where right is wrong and wrong is right, and if you speak up about what hundreds of generations have seen as wrongdoing, you are labeled a hater, a racist and intolerant or my person favorite, a homophobic. The whole world is turned upside-down.

So along comes Donald Trump who made promises to bring America back to what it used to be. The problem is that for at least two generations our society has been riddled with a cancer called Liberalism. That liberalism was taught in colleges that turned out liberal teachers who in turn have taught a generation of high school students that capitalism is bad and communism (often called socialism) is good. That is exactly the state of our nation today. The students of today have no recollection of what America was like just fifty years ago, nor do they care. When someone like Donald Trump comes on the scene it appears to the useful idiots that his ideas are foreign, dangerous and anti-American, whereas it is actually the ideas of the liberal left that are foreign, dangerous and anti-American, not only to me but to the framers of the nation as they encoded in the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution. Our Forefathers based those two documents on the ills that they saw in their day for the most part. Yes, they probably had some prophetic insight from reading various passages of scripture that mention the Last Days, but one has to wonder if they ever considered that our nation would last until the Last Days.

Enter the New Apostolic Reformation, known by the acronym of NAR. I've written more about this end-times pseudo-Christian cult that has taken over the Church at large, especially in the Pentecostal and Charismatic circles; more than any other subject. They err many ways in their theology, but specifically in two doctrines. As I mentioned earlier on, they are in error in their understanding of the Five Fold Ministry, mentioned by Rabbi Paul. They do this by perverting it to mean that Apostles and Prophets are supposed to have supreme power over the other five offices established in scripture and not only that, but they claim supreme authority over ALL believers who they see as subservient. In addition, they adhere to the Seven Mountain Doctrine, which is a mandate that they have set down (you won't find this in scripture) that says that NAR Christians (a true oxymoron) will infiltrate seven areas of society, overcome them and then change the world so that they can present a perfect world to Yeshua when he returns to Earth.

As I showed earlier, the Seven Mountain doctrine is not Christian, not Biblical, and it contradicts the very words of Yeshua who said that He would have to shorten the time leading to His return because if he didn't all flesh on earth would be destroyed. One could easily come to the notion that it is possible that the NAR will be the Beast System of Revelation. Let me state again that Al Jazeera, the Muslim news service has published an article by an author that quotes an Islamic endorsed Jew that states that the NAR is America's Taliban. I don't think that they're too far off. I talked about this in the preceding chapter.

It is my assertion that Donald Trump has the best ambitions for the American People. If he does have faith in Yeshua, it is very weak or very new. If you followed Trump events before the election you probably saw various people praying for Donald Trump. Many of those people

are NAR members. The NAR is very popular in the Charismatic movement in both North and South America, which is why it is no surprise that Ted Cruz was so popular among Latino Charismatic voters. His father, Rafael Cruz is a high-handed player in the NAR movement. He declared that his son was the anointed one, sent from YHVH to save America. When the NAR realized that Cruz was falling in popularity they hesitatingly threw their support behind Donald Trump. Why would they do that? The answer is simple, if you can't be the host, then be the parasite. I explained that in the last chapter above. The NAR has infiltrated the Trump Administration and will use Trump until it no longer needs him. They already have their plant, Michael Pence that they have groomed to take his place. Pence presents a problem however, he labels himself, "A born again Charismatic Catholic." Here we are presented with another oxymoron, seeing that the scripture is clear that those who consider themselves real Christians through a born-again relationship with YHVH Yeshua are supposed to come out of the main component of the Whore of Babylon. His statement would be akin to someone ascribing to themselves the title of "masculine male transgender female." Sorry, but in this world, you still can't have your cake and eat it too. A person is either a born-again believer or a Roman Catholic. You cannot serve two masters and if he's born-again he should know this. This casts suspicions to me that he has very little if any scriptural knowledge and I question his spiritual claims.

There are a number of ways that events can play out. It's possible that Trump would be successfully impeached in which case Pence would become the President. If this event played out, it is possible that Pence would pick Ted Cruz as a vice president. It is possible that Trump will serve a whole term and not be reelected, or that Pence would run against him in the

primaries. If Pence won, it is possible he would pick Cruz or even Romney for a vice president. It is also possible that God forbid, Trump is eliminated through violence. What I am trying to convey is that somehow the NAR will usurp Trump and will take over power. One last thought; perhaps Trump will join the NAR camp (if he hasn't already) and he will keep inserting more NAR people into key Seven Mountain areas of influence.

The Demise:

It is important to remember the generational issues that I mentioned above. Remember, at least two generations are generations of snowflakes. Add to those generations the Baby Boomer's that are liberal in nature. At least half of the nation doesn't like conservatism or what the tenants of traditional America are. Most of those people do not like Christianity or Judaism because they see both as religions that represent rules and regulations. We cannot deny that the Church at large has not represented the faith very well, and it has left a bad taste in many mouths. All of this can only get worse if the NAR gets into areas of key influence and they start forcing "religion" down the throats of people. At that time the powder keg that was lit long ago will finally explode and will lead to the election of someone who will hate Christians as much, if not more than most of the population will. They will see the NAR Regime as an authoritarian regime that will need not only to be replaced but exterminated. In addition to the extermination of the NAR, people will see it necessary to exterminate everyday Christians. Of course, by the time that the persecution comes, most of those who once called themselves believers will have cast off their feigned belief in Yeshua and they will probably participate in the rounding up and killing of real believers.

I find it very interesting that Islam is referring to the NAR as “America’s Taliban.” The fact that they adhere to the Seven Mountain principle is disturbing because the Whore of Babylon that rides the beast in the Book of Revelation happens to sit upon seven mountains. Could it be possible that the NAR is the Beast System of Revelation? Is it possible that the woman on the Beast, who is drunk on the Blood of The Saints is really the NAR? Could the NAR morph into something that would be akin to what the Roman Catholic Church was for many centuries, a persecutor of real believers? Oh, and here’s one that will really blow your mind. Is it possible that the NAR will join with Islam and Roman Catholicism to merge into that the Woman who rides upon the Beast?

I know that a lot of people have a set idea of what the last days are going to look like. The problem with that mindset is that YHVH never really makes prophecy clear, and almost always we end up seeing what His real intent was after the events have occurred. Trying to guess at what the Mind of YHVH has planned for Human History is a dangerous practice. As a matter of fact, such a practice is what has led to the formation of the NAR. One thing is for certain, the days ahead, although fearful, will be exciting to watch as they are played out. We may not have to fear Islam so much or a confederation of religions or one of humanism, the people we might be running from are those who sit in the pew next to us.
