1. Among the ancients, a weight, and a coin. The true value of the talent cannot well be ascertained, but it is known that it was different among different nations. The Attic talent the weight, contained 60 Attic minae, or 6000 Attic drachmae, equal to 56 pounds, eleven ounces, English troy weight. The mina being reckoned equal to £3 4s. 7d. sterling, or fourteen dollars and a third nearly, the talent was of the value of £193 15s sterling, about \$861 dollars. Other computations make it £225 sterling.

The Romans had the great talent and the little talent; the great talent is computed to be equal to f99 6s. 8d. sterling, and the little talent to f75 sterling.

2. talent among the Hebrews, was also a gold coin, the same with a shekel of gold; called also stater, and weighing only four drachmas.

But the Hebrew talent of silver, called cicar, was equivalent to three thousand shekels, or one hundred and thirteen pounds, ten ounces and a fraction, troy weight.

3. Faculty; natural gift or endowment; a metaphorical application of the word, said to be borrowed from the Scriptural parable of the talents. Matthew 25:24.

He is chiefly to be considered in his three different talents, as a critic, a satirist, and a writer of odes.

'Tis not my talent to conceal my thoughts.

4. Eminent abilities; superior genius; as, he is a man of talents.

[Talent, in the singular, is sometimes used in a like sense.]

5. Particular faculty; skill. He has a talent at drawing.

6. [Sp. talante, manner of performing any thing, will, disposition.] Quality; disposition.

It is interesting that the origin of the word has something to do with scales. Balanced scales are indicative of justice and fairness. This meaning could hardly be ascribed to actors because of their venomous rhetoric toward those that they do not agree with. In this regard, their scales and/or balances are tilted toward one direction. It is also interesting that the term was also ascribed to measures of silver and gold. Silver and gold are both payment methods and we all know that actors are paid way too much for the work that they do.

We see that the next definition says that the word can be tacked on someone with a natural gift or endowment. Perhaps this can be better seen by the construction worker that goes to see the doctor for a pain in his side. The doctor has a talent in medicine and can heal the man, but probably doesn't have the skill to build an addition onto his house. The patient cannot heal himself, but he can contract with the doctor to build the addition onto the doctor's home. Each has separate and distinct talents. Yes, you could say that actors are talented when it comes to parroting a script or conjuring up emotion for their part. And yes, sometimes an actor is good

enough to get his or her audience to feel the part that the actor is playing, however it ends there. The actor appeals to emotions whereas the doctor and construction worker create things that are useful, helpful and long lasting. Actors are never long lasting. For instance, very few of you can name three actors that were famous during the silent film era, but you know that Clara Barton formed the American Red Cross and that Frank Lloyd Wright built some of the most unique architecture that Americans have ever seen. I work with people that belong to the millennial generation. Sometimes I will bring up actors like Carey Grant or The Marx Brothers only to get a blank stare.

Next, we see that talent can mean that a person has had genius bestowed upon them. Having done a word study of the word “genius” I have discovered that having that name as ascribed to someone is not a good thing. You see, genius’ etymology works all the way back to the Arabic word where we get the word “genie.” The word in Islamic culture means literally “demon.” They believe that there are good demons and bad demons, but truth be told, we as believers in Yahweh Yeshua know that there are only bad demons. In essence, saying that someone is a genius is saying that they have been given an endowment by a demonic spirit. This definition fits well with actors and other entertainers who are imitators of original things and who spin things off in their own direction. Personally I would love to audition all of the famous actors to see how well they can act out the “Five I Wills of Lucifer,” that are found in Isaiah the fourteenth chapter. I’d be willing to bet that they would all ace that audition.

We finally come to the last two definitions of “talent.” First, we find that it could mean a particular skill. The Webster’s 1828 lists such a talent as drawing, but I’ve known people that create works of art with wood, with pipe and even with rebuilding automobile engines. The last definition has to do with character, will and disposition. I see this as being talent just as much and sometimes more than all of the other talents that I’ve written about so far. What about the man that can walk away from a group of people that are throwing insults at him? That surely is talent. What about the married couple, each working two jobs to provide for their family and so that they can provide a college education for their children. Believe me, it takes talent to juggle things around so that family harmony and health is preserved. What about the man or woman that stays with a contentious spouse? That takes a lot of talent. And, what about the believer in Yeshua who will not go with the other sheep when they are heading toward destruction? They are often ridiculed, mocked and forced to leave church after church. That takes talent. This is everyday talent, not something read from a script and it’s not something that is a job that will be done in six months, but can go on for a lifetime.

Did you ever wonder why actors get burned out? Did you ever wonder why their marriages often end in divorce time after time after time? The simple answer is that they live one life during the day and another at night. In effect, they are serving two masters, one being fantasy and the other being reality. Yeshua said that such people will tend to cling to one master and hate the other, and, being worldly, they often get their priorities wrong and serve the master that gives them fame and fortune.

So, when actors and other famous people get onto television, or radio, or when they grandstand at award ceremonies it is no wonder why they lean toward the political party that doesn't hold them accountable, and also, religions that do not hold them accountable. Can you understand now why they hate conservatives as well as Followers of Yeshua and Religious Jews. In their lives they not only live in a fantasy world for weeks at a time, over and over again, but they have to live in the real world and the two clash. So, we have people that can barely hold it together that also take politics onto their plate and it just doesn't work. They are a whole group of people who are confused in the first place, not knowing reality from fantasy. They are literally insane. Trust me, I work with people like this during my work week.
