

SATAN HAS HIJACKED THE CHARISMATIC MOVEMENT

I was saved in Yeshua back in 1979. At this time the Charismatic Movement of Christianity was just getting a start. Many of us saw it as a revival of the Pentecostal Movement that started earlier in the century. To many of us the Pentecostal Movement has become dry in many ways or it had been taken to extremes by people in the Oneness Movement. For anyone who doesn't know about the Oneness Movement, they were also known as the Jesus Only Movement, aka United Pentecostal Church; a group that believes that Jesus is the Father, Son and Holy Ghost, thus denying the Trinity. To them, there was only one baptism in water, that being that a person needed to be baptized in the name of Jesus only. They were sort of a freakish group that demanded that their women never cut their hair, always dress in ankle long dresses, wear head coverings and the men had to wear suits, ties and slacks. They also liked to go to other churches and disrupt them with their chants of hallelujahs and running around the churches clapping and acting like complete morons. When they would arrive at Walter Martin (author of Kingdom of The Cults) seminars they would make complete asses out of themselves, always proving correct the warning by Martin that this would happen since they were there.

The Charismatic Movement arrived and at first it was a blessing. I had the pleasure of attending a Vineyard Christian Fellowship as my second church. A few of us would drive from Vacaville, California up to Placerville, California to attend services. We didn't mind the trip because services at the Vineyard were awesome. We would enter into worship and continue worship for sometimes an hour and a half after which time Pastor Rick would preach for half an hour and church was over. I can't describe the feelings that I felt during these worship times. It is so true when the Scripture says that Yahweh inhabits the praises of His People. I also felt a oneness with the people at the Placerville Church, a unity that I never felt in any other Christian Church.

After about a year of attending this "second" church it was announced that the church had grown so quickly, and that since many of the people attending were driving up from the Sacramento area, that there would be a new offshoot of this church in the Sacramento area. Things were never the same after that. It was as though this decision was made by man, and not by Yahweh. Feeling that it was fruitless to continue the long drive every Sunday night many of us decided to just stay in Vacaville and attend our Pentecostal Assemblies of God Church. That began to sour too when it was revealed that the pastor was a whoremonger and a thief. I then

attended a Four-Square church the next town up from us and although it was adequate, it was nothing like what I had experienced in Placerville. I started to become disillusioned with church. I had tasted real spiritual freedom and had experienced Yahweh in such intimate ways that all other churches were just adequate and many were real disappointments. The problem only grew worse when I started to notice that the Vineyard Church was changing too. The spirit at the Vineyard just didn't feel the same and I felt that things were going to be heading down a road that I didn't want to be part of. I just stopped going to church altogether after that.

I have to admit something. I know that I always tell people to be in fellowship with other believers, in other words, a church, but for a on and off period of about six years I didn't attend church. I still worshipped at home and I still prayed and such, but I did slide back in my walk a bit; started listening to the old Rock and Roll again and such. I did grow in faith, as strange as that might seem. Since I wasn't attending a church regularly, I had to rely on Yahweh more and more and it seemed that there was a time of greater intimacy during that time. So, I can understand when people tell me that they are done with church and things like that. I really do. However, there is a problem with thinking that you can be an island and be free from fellowship. Islands need support from the mainland to be prosperous. They can exist as an entity, but they cannot advance like they do when they have fellowship with places that can give them things that the island just cannot produce. While I was growing in my knowledge of Yahweh, and my relationship with him seemed to grow, I was missing out on corporate worship and the love (and aggravation) that other believers can give. Being part of a body, I was only one body part and I was suffering because I was missing the rest of the body and the body was missing this body part.

During the last few years of the 90's I started to attend a church in Sacramento. I came to know of this church (Last Days Harvest Ministries) via a woman that I met on a dating service. We never dated but became good friends. She had informed Pastor Tom about my ministry and he wanted to meet me right away. From the moment that we met we realized that we had a kinship and I started to attend his church. Tom described himself as a mixture of Presbyterian and Pentecostal much like I consider myself a Bapticostal; both of us liking the fundamental ways of the older churches and the freedom of the Pentecostal movement. After 25 years I finally found a church where I was comfortable and I felt like I could feel free to worship in.

Now I want to make it clear that I believe in the Five Fold ministry for the Church as laid out in Scripture:

And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: Ephesians 4:11-13

In this scripture Rabbi Paul clearly says that these offices will exist until all come into unity of faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of Yahweh. Seeing that ignorance seems to be growing leaps and bounds and that there has been and still is division within the body of Mashiah, this proves that the offices are still in effect and will be until the return of Yahweh Yeshua.

I also believe that there are other things that, in addition to the above are still valid for this day:

Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular. And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. 1 Corinthians 12:27-28

Those in the Charismatic NAR movement try to use this scripture to establish a hierarchy in the church. I can see where this mistake could be made. However, if you read it over and over again you see that the order is a process, not offices. Apostles by nature establish churches, that is their function. Then prophets come onto the scene to bring words from Yahweh to enforce faith in Yahweh. After prophets, teachers are brought in to affirm the essentials of faith and to help people move from babes' milk to solid food (to use an analogy). Then, when a church is working well and in the will of Yahweh brings miracles and gifts of healings to increase faith and as a witness to the unsaved. Then when faith is firmly established people want to help each other, just like in the Book of Acts; people will help the sick, the widow and the fatherless. Then some sort of church order has to be established, usually with a pastor as the head with deacons and elders to keep each other in check. Diversity of tongues comes when the church members are Baptized in the Ruach Ha Kodesh upon which time miracles and healings usually become part of the ministry of many of the church members, thus the whole body of believers is used to its fullest extent. Once that church is firmly established, then it will send out Apostles and the whole process will start up again with the planting of new fellowships. You see, Rabbi Paul never meant for this scripture to be used for hierarchy purposes, but it takes men to twist it into being used for that purpose.

Yes, I do believe miracles and healings happen today as well as the gift of tongues. And I do stress, that any one of these things denote a filling of the Ruach Ha Kodesh. I am vehemently opposed to those that teach that the only manifestation of the Ruach is the Gift of Tongues. Tongues is A manifestation, not the manifestation. As I was attending church at LDHM I was reading about things like “The Toronto Blessing,” “The Pensacola Revival” and other such things. What I read really alarmed me. I read that in Toronto they had an event that they dubbed “holy laughter,” where people would just break out in laughter for minutes on end and sometimes for hours. This was happening during what was supposed to be church services. This was clearly disorder within the church as not all the people were hit with this manifestation. Then I started to read about even more bizarre events, like people snorting like pigs and barking like dogs during revival times. Then I heard that people claimed that they were finding gold fillings in their mouths and others were finding gold dust and still others were finding diamonds in the church. Others were seeing what they called angel’s feathers falling from the ceiling of the church. This I found very disturbing because angels for the most part manifest as men minus the feathers. If the feathers did come from an angel then they would have come from a cherub. I can assure you that every time that a human has encountered one of the cherubim they usually fell to their faces and were not able to move and many times not even speak. The truly bizarre occurred when one church was claiming to have angelic visitations by angels that appeared in spheroid balls of light. Those of us who study the signs of demonic and fallen angelic visitation see that they often come in the appearance of “orbs,” which is exactly what was manifesting in this particular church. Yes, they were angels, but not the kind I would want around.

Upon further investigation I studied something called the Kundalini spirit. When this spirit is present, it usually manifest by people having writhing movements, something akin to epileptic seizures, also with unusual involuntary body movements. We’ve all heard of the Antichrist, the person who will someday be a false Messiah who will someday dupe the world into believing that he is Yeshua and the savior of this world. What many don’t know is that there is an anti-Holy Spirit, something that the Hindu’s call the Kundalini spirit. It shows up many times in Charismatic churches and is said to be the Ruach Ha Kodesh, but is a poor counterfeit. The problem is that when people are not familiar with the real Ruach Ha Kodesh, they can be duped to believe that a counterfeit spirit is the Ruach Ha Kodesh. The following view is from a supposed “church” service in South Africa. When you watch it check out how the people start having uncontrollable body spasms and then obey a command to go out and eat grass outside the church. Listen carefully as the “supposed pastor” mocks them as they obey his commands:

Notice also that the pastor took scripture totally out of context. He says that Yeshua turned the loaves of bread given at the feeding of the multitude, actually turned it into his body. Spiritually and scripturally ignorant people always believe lies by charlatans like this. Now you might think that what these people have done, such as eating grass and believing that the bread actually turned into Yeshua's body is stupid, right? But what about snorting like pigs and mooing like cows and barking like dogs. What about uncontrollable laughter and people writing around in services here in America? And what about grave sucking, where people are told that one obscure scripture says that you can lay on the grave of a deceased believer and suck up the unused Ruach Ha Kodesh power that lingers around that dead body. Is it also equally as inane to believe that Yahweh would manifest himself with the very things that he says corrupt men, speaking of gold dust and diamonds appearing at services? And would a church be running around like a room full of lunatics catching angels' feathers if the power of Yahweh showed up in a Cherub? If you mumbled something like, "poor stupid deceived people," when you watched the video, there are many like myself that mumble "poor deceived people," when the American church touts the manifestations that I mentioned earlier in this paragraph. If you believe those things, you're no different than those who sat out and ate grass and listened to a mocking deceiver in South Africa.

What is happening in the American Church and in Charismatic churches around the world is that the Kundalini spirit has come in and convinced ignorant people who are led by charlatans, that it is the Ruach Ha Kodesh (Holy Spirit) and people have bought into it hook line and sinker. A whole generation of people, and now it is generations of people have become ignorant because they have not read scripture and asked the real Ruach Ha Kodesh to show them the truth in scripture. Instead, they listen to a man or men up on stage (yes, it's a stage and not a pulpit), or they have gone to their local "Christian" bookstore and they have bought books by people who "explain" the Bible to them. It is in this manner that people become ignorant of what is truth and they believe a lie. Our ministry constantly reminds people to check everything that is said (even by us) with what is in scripture. Scripture is Yahweh's lie detector and if you're adept in studying scripture then you will spot a counterfeit every time. Let's look at an important scripture:

For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints. 1 Corinthians 14:33

The Greek word for "confusion" in this scripture is "*akatastasia*," and it is defined as: instability, a state of disorder, disturbance, confusion. Doesn't this describe what you

saw in the video and/or what you find in Charismatic churches when people are making animal noises, searching for gold dust and diamonds, reaching out for angel's feathers and/or they are writhing around like they are demon possessed. Isn't a person unstable when they want to lay on a grave because they lust after the "left overs" of the Ruach that they think resides with the departed saints. The definition of *akatastasia* describes the actions and motives of the New Apostolic Revival, Dominionism and Replacement Theology; all of which come from and cause a spirit of confusion by cherry-picking scriptures to take out of context to satisfy their own lusts and the lusts of those who have itching ears.

The scripture says that Yahweh is the author of "Peace." The Greek word for peace in this scripture is "*eirēnē*," and the definition that applies to this particular text is: *of Christianity, the tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and content with its earthly lot, of whatsoever sort that is.* This is what Yahweh is the author of. He is not the author of people running around trying to suck up remnants of the Ruach Ha Kodesh, nor lust for signs and wonders because those things are sought out by those who are unsure of their faith. The sign seekers and those who lust for more are not satisfied with what Yahweh offers and they want more and more. This attitude is not Messiah-like and it opens up doors for the enemy to come in. They come to faith with their house swept clean but they leave the doors open so that their former demons can come back and bring the Kundalini spirit with them. You can tell the difference between one possessed by the Kundalini spirit and those that have the Ruach Ha Kodesh indwelling them. Simply, those who fall under the influence of the Kundalini spirit always want more and more and are never satisfied. They usually demean those who have the Ruach Ha Kodesh who are content with what Yahweh has given to them. Kundalini people want, lust and conquer. Those who have the Ruach Ha Kodesh wait on Yahweh and are satisfied with what they have and are blessed when we get more. We know that Yahweh does all things in His timing and is not a respecter of men, lest any man boast. Boasting is a prominent feature of Kundalini people. And finally, those of us indwelled with the genuine Ruach Ha Kodesh realize that Yeshua is the conqueror and that unless Yahweh builds the house, they labor in vain that do it themselves.

If you've read this and are part of the Charismatic, NAR, Dominionism camp and Yahweh has spoken to your heart that what has been said here is true, then please flee from that Beast system. Many elements of the Charismatic movement are Antichrist in nature and true believers are forbidden to have anything to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness. You might have a form of godliness, but you deny the TRUE power thereof. Churches are supposed to be orderly and peaceful and Yahweh works much better in such situations. And finally, you have to

make the decision of whether you want to hear Yeshua call you a good and faithful servant, or hearing Him say to go away because he never knew you.
