

THE TELEVISION SERIES – RESURRECTION – IS TAKING THE TURN THAT I FORMALLY WROTE ABOUT

I'd like to give a little bit of background before I proceed. A few years ago, when my first wife went to be with Yeshua, I was mourning quite a bit. If you've ever lost a spouse you know how that is. I was telling Yeshua that I missed her so much, so very much. One day, while I was talking to Yahweh in a dream, I heard quite audibly, Him tell me that I would see her again, but it would not be her. It seemed like a stern warning that I not be duped when it happened.

Like so many things, I shared this with Jim Wilhelmsen. Scripture says that the prophets are subject to the spirit of the prophets and I have no problem bouncing things off of Jim and one or two others if I need clarification. However, when I shared this with Jim, I heard a silence on the other end of the phone. When Jim finally spoke, he informed me that a few years earlier he too had a dream. In that dream his deceased parents were around again and he was very happy. He noticed after a little while however that they were spouting New Age lies and he realized that they were counterfeits. Now, bear in mind, both of these dreams happened years in advance of the show "Resurrection."

I have always been under the assumption that there is an insidious reason for alien abduction. I believe that the fallen angels that disguise themselves as "aliens," or "extraterrestrials," are taking the sperm from their male abductees, and the ovum of their female abductees for the reason of producing a population of living bodies, devoid of souls, so that the spirits of the fallen Nephilim can inhabit them and again walk the earth. The Nephilim were the product of the union between fallen angels and human females before the flood, done physically, but done now in a clinical setting where these bodies can be turned out in mass numbers very quickly. I believe that the Nephilim want to try to gain access into heaven, which they are now not permitted to do. In their own foolish manner, I believe that they somehow believe that if they inhabit a human body, when that body dies, they will get the reward of that body, a resurrection. There are some other intricacies that fall into this whole thing, but it would take too long to discuss them.

However, there could be another insidious deed that these clones of the dead could do that would help to bring about a mass defection from faith in Yahweh. Let me illustrate. Everyone would love to see their dearly departed relatives and friends. I happen to believe that there are angels that are assigned to us that are familiar with our lives and protect us when

needed. I also believe that there are familiar demonic spirits that hang around us our entire lifetime, and they know everything about us, even things said in secret and confidences to others. So, let's use my deceased wife for an example. Yes, I know that I'll get to see her in heaven and when we return with Yeshua at the end of all things. But what if my faith was not strong, or I had no faith (speaking of a faith in Yeshua by knowing Him and knowing His Word). So, one day there is a knock at my door and I open it to discover my deceased wife standing there. She looks like a carbon copy, speaks Spanglish, laughs, cries and acts just like the woman that I loved and married. I am so taken in by this that I start to believe the doctrine that she starts to feed me. Just like in Jim's dream, she starts to tell me that the Bible isn't the Word of Yahweh and that the New Age has the plan of salvation more correct than any church has taught me. She tells me that if I listen to her, I will know the truth and the lies I've been fed all of these years will soon fade away. Having longed for her I start to listen because I'd like to be with her more than anything in the world. I remind you that this is just an example, I love my current wife dearly. So, I walk away from the faith and believe the lie.

But let's throw some more things into the mix. Let's say that the news comes on and says that millions of people have disappeared from the earth. They weren't those strong in the Christian faith, but were just people that did good and tried to love other people. Then, right about that time, those relatives show up, claiming to have been resurrected and claiming to know the truth. Again, my deceased wife starts to tell me where I went wrong and how I missed the rapture. However, she explains to me, there is a chance to redeem myself; just take the mark that this new world leader is offering. She says that he can give me a new body right now and that will seal the deal. If I'm ignorant, I'll listen and be deceived; but I seem to remember hearing Yahweh tell me in a dream that if Lourdes did come back, it wouldn't really be her and it clicks, this is the great deception. This is one danger in believing in a Pre-Trib rapture because the lie can be placed upon people who are already on shaky ground where scripture is concerned. They've banked on the rapture, missed what they thought was the real rapture and accept a lie.

But getting back to that TV show, "Resurrection," here's the plot so far. There's this little town in Missouri where from time to time, dead relatives seem to come back to life. In the past they were killed and destroyed and it was soon learned that if one of the returned decided that they didn't want to be there, they would disappear forever and never again return. The story has some of the current characters being killed and returning during the episode. To be fair, the writers have shown that some people would accept it right away, some would need convincing and a minority would regret that their relative returned. There is one character, a young woman who had conceived just before committing suicide a few years back who returns

and they soon realize that she's pregnant. Of course, the government is all over this and is keeping every returned person without a relative to support them, locked up in a facility. Two weeks ago, a strange preacher showed up, returned of course. He was known as being a charlatan in his past life but seems to be on the mend, trying to correct his mistakes. In this week's episode, this pastor somehow received a message from (the story wants you to think it is God) who tells the pastor that the child is really the Antichrist. Earlier in the show tonight, when the mother was having contractions prior to childbirth, all of the "returned" walked down to the place where she was giving birth and the ones in lockup stared out the window in the direction of the town located in Missouri. They seemed to be in a trance that nobody could stop. The pastor feels that this trance that they were all in was produced by the child who is able to control them through some sort of telepathy. The end of the show was interesting. The government lady, who is a statistician and who uses algorithms to figure out probabilities of when returning events will happen, stumbles upon the fact that this late returning event brought more people than ever before. She surmises that the next event will be much bigger. At the end of this week's show, her computer screen starts showing little red dots, indicating that people are returning on a massive return, not only in the little town in Missouri, but all over the world, millions if not billions.

The impression that I was left with was that these people fit perfectly into the dreams that both Jim and I both had. These demonic hordes, in cloned human bodies return to deceive the world and cause a great falling away. I mean, come on. We have Christians running around thinking that they can perform necromancy by sucking Ruach Ha Kodesh power from dead believers and nobody questions it? The bigger churches are teaching doctrines of demons and nobody there seems to care. Through laziness, Christians have allowed themselves to be lulled to sleep in the light. Many deny sin and sin's penalty. We have the likes of Rick Warren trying to meld Catholicism, Protestantism and Islam into one religion. We have him telling us that the Pope is the Pope of all believers. The sad thing is that nobody is questioning it. I have a relative through marriage. She's a big Rick Warren fan. One day I asked her a question about Warren, stating some of the stuff that he's been reported to have said, reported by reliable and trustworthy sources and many times by Warren himself. I asked if she had heard anything about those things. Her reply was, "our pastor is friends with Rick Warren and if he likes Rick then Rick must be a trustworthy and upright man." Since when do we approve of someone because another man approves of them. NO, they have to pass the litmus test of scripture. If they pass that test, then they are worthy to be heard and considered.

Over the past twenty to thirty years I have noticed that there has been a separation going on within the Body of Mashiach. Yahweh is separating the sheep from the goats and He's

separating the wheat from the tares. People that I thought would never walk away from Yahweh are doing and saying some of the most vile and moronic things and are proving that they are not part of Yahweh's flock. Not one of this man's supposed "Christian" relatives hung their head in shame or expressed that it made them uncomfortable to admit these things in a court of law. Yahweh's Elect see these things and it abhors them; the tares act like it is normal activity and they don't even have the discernment to question how this is bad fruit, borne by a bad tree.

You see, a society that is so calloused, so shallow where faith is concerned and so watered down as to dismiss sin as being normal will fall for the lie that the writers of "Revelation" are placing right before their unsuspecting audience.
