

THE WORLD SERIES FLAG TEAR WAS NOT A COINCIDENCE

I'm not one that believes in coincidences. As far as I'm concerned, everything happens for a reason. If we want to know the reason, we can reason it out, or we can ask Yahweh to reveal the meaning. I wrote a blog entry a few months back about how Yahweh talked to me when I was complaining about what seem to be that all the traffic lights were turning red and holding up my progress as I drove along to an appointment. First of all, the complaining was stupid because had I left 30 seconds earlier the lights might have all been green, but the most important thing I was told was that Yahweh knew back before he created Heaven and Earth that those light would all be red on that particular time in history. In other words, I just needed to relax and know that Yahweh has my best interest at heart. Look at all of the variables. Although these things didn't happen, what could have occurred. Well, I could have gotten to one of the lights and someone coming from my left or right could have run a light and killed me. Since I was going to the bank before going to school, there could have been a robbery which could have ended my life had I gotten there while the robbers were still there. A meteor could have hit my truck had I been in the wrong place at the wrong time. See what I mean? He knows what is best for me, and when and where I should be when He wants me to be there.

I was looking at the news the other day and noticed an article that caught my immediate attention. The article stated that at the beginning of the 3rd game of the World Series, held at the ballpark in San Francisco, the giant American flag which was being held up by people on the field, had developed a tear.



I looked at the picture and knew that there was a message here. As we all know, the stripes on the American Flag represent the original 13 Colonies/States of the United States. I have not found any source that states an order for the stripes where states are concerned. The stars in the blue field represent the States in the Union. The color white stands for purity and innocence. The red in the flag stands for valor and bravery. the blue in the field stands for vigilance, perseverance and justice.

Now, most of you know my stance on citing the Pledge of Allegiance so I will not go into that. However, let's look at the Pledge and see where our nation has run afoul of that pledge:

"I PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND TO THE REPUBLIC FOR WHICH IT STANDS, ONE NATION UNDER GOD, INDIVISIBLE, WITH LIBERTY AND JUSTICE FOR ALL."

Notice that the pledge that I found was from an official United States Government source as that is important. It means that this is the official Pledge and it is punctuated in the official way that the government recognizes the Pledge. Notice that it says that our nation is "one nation under God." In other words, when our nation is under Yahweh, He is the one that makes the nation "one." Indivisible means that it cannot be divided and of course there is liberty and justice for all. The comma after the word "stands," turns the rest of the words into descriptors. So, when a person cites the Pledge, they are saying that they're pledging allegiance to the flag, which is a symbol of the United States of America, which is a Republic (not a Democracy). After the comma, we see attributes of the nation. The first descriptor states that the nation is "one nation under God," but what does that mean. Some might argue that it is proclaiming that the nation is literally one nation with God as its leader. Others, like myself believe that given the current condition of our nation, that the phrase means that as long as we are under Yahweh, we will be one nation. It makes more sense if we look at the next descriptor, "indivisible." The only way that something can be indivisible is if something strong is holding it together, either molecularly or by a bonding agent. We know by Scripture that Yahweh is what is holding every together. So, the two descriptors are then rendered:

"One nation, that while under (obedient to) God, is indivisible."

Okay, now let's look at the last descriptor, "with liberty and justice for all." This descriptor is again indicative of the need for a higher power to guarantee that there remains liberty and justice for all. Show me any nation or kingdom on earth, every, where there was

liberty and justice for all. A case could be made for ancient Israel, when the Torah was new and it was upheld by Moses and Aaron, a brief period indeed.

The only way that the Pledge could make sense, and could be fulfilled is if moral and honest people recite it and the nation is under Yahweh. In its correct wording, the Pledge would read:

“I PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND TO THE REPUBLIC FOR WHICH IT STANDS, AND ONLY WHEN IT IS OBEDIENT AND SERVING GOD (YAHWEH) WILL IT BE ONE NATION AND ONLY THEN WILL IT BE INDIVISIBLE AND ONLY THEN WILL THERE BE LIBERTY AND JUSTICE FOR ALL.”

You see, there was a time when the above was true. Some might argue that America has always has unfairness and such. However, back at its founding this country was more puritanical and had a fidelity to Yahweh. Yes, there were wicked people who founded this nation just as there were righteous people that did also. However, the majority of people were Bible reading, God fearing individuals who loved Yahweh. However, in our current time our nation has been taken over by elites who haven driven Yahweh out of our land and who plan on destroying Jews and Christians and erase any memory of Yahweh ever having prospered our land.

Now we started out talking about the flag being torn at the opening ceremonies of the 3rd game of the World Series of Baseball. First of all, let’s look at where this event occurred. Game 3 was played in San Francisco, which is probably the best example of a modern-day Sodom and/or Gomorrah. It is “wickedness central” where social morality goes. Second, it happened in California, which is where most of the nation agrees the new and strange ideas come from. If America is Babylon and Babylon has two centers, moral and economic; San Francisco would be the capital of Immoral Babylon; New York being the economic capital.

We affirm that the 13 stripes on the US Flag represent the 13 original States, which were formally the 13 colonies of the English Empire’s claim on North America. We also know that the 13 states that currently exist are divided by their socioeconomic political stands. Seven states tend to lean heavily toward the liberal (socio-communistic) mode of thought while 6 of those states lean toward the conservative (Republic) mode of thought and belief. Interestingly, the flag split so that it divided the flag with 7 stripes on top and 6 stripes on the bottom. I don’t see that as a coincidence. Now remember that those 7 seven states tend to lean more toward socialism/communism. To the flag’s top and to the left is the blue field which contains the 50

stars that represent the 50 states of the entire Union. The split in the flag was between lines 7 and 8. Remember, that the 7 liberal states are at the top. Had the tear continued it would have taken the blue field with the stars along with it. What significance would that have? Well, we see that the liberal work of dividing and destroying our nation continues unabated for the most part. Each day our nation grows more and more divided. Eventually, if this nation doesn't repent and return to Yahweh, the tear will continue and the corruption of the 7 rebellious states will influence and carry away the whole nation with their corruption.

This nation hasn't had Yahweh as its focus for several decades. It has ceased to be a nation "under God." There is a constant dividing that is happening on so many different levels; race, economy, moral, religious.... and there is no indication that this downward spiral will stop anytime soon. My feeling is that the spiral will continue because many Christians are too proud to bow a knee, admit their sins and ask for forgiveness; which are the things that Yahweh demands for us to do in order for him to come and heal our land. I also feel that The United States is the reincarnation (applicable term for these purposes) or ancient Babylon; all indications lead to that conclusion. If this is true, then the destruction of The United States as we knew it is imminent and ordained for end-time events. Christians and Jews will not be free people anymore, but hated residents of Babylon.

Being a born-again believer in Yeshua Ha Mashiach (Jesus Christ), I see the tear in the flag as a warning to all of us that bad times are ahead, but also that there is hope if Christians would become humble, admit their sins and pray to heaven for help. I can only imagine that those in the Illuminati and NWO camp see this as a victory, as a sign that their plans are working and they see that sign coming from Lucifer. I know that things are going to get harder and harder for those of us that worship Yahweh. Some of us might lose our lives for the sake of Yeshua. Many will cave in and go over to the other side. It is time to choose you this day which kingdom you are going to serve. Are you going to serve Babylon with all of its lustful enticements, all which will burn in the fire of Yahweh's wrath? Or, will you serve and obey Yahweh Yeshua, whose rewards are heavenly and everlasting.
